



2-Week Trial Program Policy

1. Overview

Phoenix AcroDance Academy (PADA) is pleased to offer a two-week trial program for new students for £15 per person, giving them the opportunity to experience our term-time classes with no obligation to continue.

The trial fee covers the full 14-day period, not individual classes.

Participation in the trial is optional; new students may also choose to enrol directly into classes via the online portal without completing a trial.

2. Classes Included in the Trial

- Monday – Acrobatic Arts
- Monday – Body Flexibility, Stability & Mobility
- Tuesday – Hand Balancing Arts
- Tuesday – Limbering & Tumbling Arts
- Thursday – Aerial Arts
- Saturday – Acrobatic Arts
- Saturday – Body Conditioning & Body Wellbeing

3. Classes Excluded from the Trial

- Tuesday – Advanced Acrobatic Arts
- Friday – All Classes
- PADA Performing Team Sessions

4. Payment Terms

The trial fee is £15 per person, non-refundable.

Payment must be made within 3 days of enrolment, or immediately if the trial begins within those 3 days.

An e-invoice will be issued by the academy.

Please ensure payment is made only after receiving an active invoice.

Once payment is received, the student's place in the trial will be confirmed and a trial confirmation email will be sent.

5. Trial Duration

The two-week trial covers 14 consecutive days from the selected start date.

Students may attend any selected eligible classes within this period.

6. Eligibility

The two-week trial is available once per student.

After a student has either completed the trial or chosen to join PADA without using the trial, they will not be eligible for a future trial once membership has commenced.

7. Class Availability

Participation in the trial does not guarantee a place in any class.

To secure a space, parents or carers may enrol via the online portal during or after the trial period.

Class enrolments are processed on a first-come, first-served basis.

8. Standards & Conduct

All trial participants are required to follow PADA Standards and student expectations, just as full members do.

This ensures a safe, positive, and supportive environment for all students.

9. Direct Enrolment Option

The trial program is optional.

New students may choose to enrol directly into classes without completing a trial by using the online portal.

Phoenix AcroDance Academy staff are responsible for the implementation of this policy and for ensuring that it is reviewed annually and updated as required. ***Next Review: September 2027***
