The District will consider and act upon the following matters:


1. Call to order and establish a quorum.
2. To receive public comments.
3. Reading and approval of minutes of prior meetings.
4. Correspondence received by or sent by HCESD No. 14
 - a. Woodforest National Bank account statement
 - b. Woodforest National Bank Collateral Pledge Report
 - c. Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts Sales and Use Tax Allocation Report
5. To review and act on District financial matters, including:
 - a. Monthly financial report from San Jacinto Tax Services
 - b. Monthly report from Investment Officer and action on investments
 - c. Payment of bills and invoices
6. Report from Highlands Volunteer Fire Department:
 - a. Fire and EMS Response Report
 - b. HVFD Treasurer's Report
 - c. Requests for routine monthly operations funds
 - d. Special requests for funds, including approval of funding for capital purchases, including vehicles
 - e. Report from HVFD regarding operational matters
7. To review and take action on the ratification of a continuing Contract with Linebarger Goggan Blair & Sampson, LLP pursuant to §6.30 of the Tax Code for the collection of delinquent District ad valorem property taxes and providing for the payment of up to 20% of the delinquent taxes, penalties, and interest which are collected by the attorney under said Contract.
8. To discuss and take action on the imposition of additional penalty on delinquent taxes pursuant to §33.07 of the Tax Code and adoption of a Resolution regarding same for taxes.
9. To discuss and take action on the imposition of additional penalty on delinquent taxes to defray costs of collection by the District's delinquent tax attorney, pursuant to §33.08 of the Tax Code and adoption of a Resolution regarding same.
10. To discuss and take action on the imposition of early additional penalty for collection costs for taxes imposed on personal property on delinquent taxes pursuant to §33.11 of the Tax Code and adoption of a Resolution regarding same.

11. To review, discuss and take action on design professional to begin the process of construction for a new fire station.
12. To review and take any action regarding real estate, including sale, purchase, lease, platting, utilities, encumbrances, maintenance and legal actions related to real estate.
13. To review and act on claims, lawsuits, or Public Information Act requests.
14. To review and act regarding District funding for HVFD participation in the Texas Emergency Services Retirement System, VFIS length of service award program and other programs.
15. To review and act regarding HCESD No. 14 and Highlands VFD facilities, including construction, maintenance, repairs, and utilities.
