Questions by new members: ie. How much money do we currently have in the funds? \$500,000. Where will the rest come from? Fundraising and possible loan

Alan Thornburg presented our packets: Discipline, Current Parcel info and valuation, lot picture, current building facts and dimensions, current building shortcomings determined in 2019, Worship attendance and membership. Tim Reilly presented a 2.5 mile radius map, Shepherd Hills Master Plan map, and map for possible vacant land to the East toward the growth of the base and new neighborhood development.

Funding is the first line of business! Capitol Campaign templates from the Foundation. Alan Thornburg to invite Bob Rudebush to our next meeting.

Existing Congregation comes First!!! Recognition that our current church does not serve our current congregation well. Want to keep them informed!

Tim Reilly to write a Building Committee Update for the Newsletter. Tim Reilly to create a tab on our Webpage for Building Committee Updates and minutes. Also to create a tab for Giving to the Building Fund.

Discussion that our decisions are for God and for the future of the church and future people to come.

Discussion that all possibilities would come to the church for vote at additional Charge Conferences. The building committee shall present: A) the preliminary architectural plans; B) the preliminary cost estimate; C) the preliminary financial plan; and D) the building committee's recommendation.

Discussion of Scott McCaskell's idea of filling in the basement and lowering the floor of the existing church building to at least use the current sanctuary as a fellowship hall. Meeting was adjourned with a tour on the outside of the current building to visualize.
