

Building Committee Meeting #29 April 23, 2026, 5:30 held at KHUMC

It was moved by Bill M. and 2nd by Brian L. to approve meeting minutes for February 5th and March 11, 2026. Motions passed.

Discussion regarding creating a Financial Planning Subcommittee. Jamie McMurtrey, Janette Jackmovich, and Tim Reilly have volunteered. There were no further nominations. It was moved by Brian L. and 2nd by Rod T. and The Building Committee voted to approve the 3 members to draft the preliminary financial plan for “defraying the total project cost”, to be submitted to the Conference Building Committee for approval and to be used to educate our congregation. The Financial Planning Subcommittee can look for an additional member to represent the congregation if needed and will begin searching for grants and financial support.

Jamie reviewed the 4 pages of information that she has worked on to, review for our Building committee for reflection and prepare us for informational meetings with the congregation. Input was requested on each page and Jamie will update per discussion

Amy with CCC will colorize the elevations when it becomes time to present our preliminary proposal to the Conference Building Committee.

Cassidy with CCC suggests that we leave the site plan as shown for now. If it is changed now to reduce cost, the City may change their requirements between now and the time of construction. Sight and building revisions can be made in Phase 2 when we proceed.

Amy with CCC is also the architect for CCC’s project on East Anamosa, West of Elk Vale.

Discussion regarding the DS comment of needing 70% of the budget prior to starting to build. Question: A house only requires 20% down and borrow 80%, why are we different?

Discussion about presenting to the congregation the information that we have now and how to present the information. We would like Tim to start working on a script and slides.
