Pastor's Report:

Short term leave update: Sharla will be gone for the month of June. Sunday Worship are mostly taken care of as is music. Love Inc. might potentially lead the first Sunday of June as a Dakota's Conference is also happening the same day which makes all pastors unavailable since attendance of the conference is mandatory. Laura Walters has offered to step up for emergencies.

Mary Wood offered her grandson's music for use in the church since we are still looking for additional musicians although his music would have to be streamed. Nicholas Stein is his real name, but his stage name is "Nick Flint". He writes his own music.

Sharla wants to induct new members in May.

A letter from a homeschool group was sent here, looking for a facility to hold their school plus they wanted donations and other freebies. The answer will be NO.

MIRACLE offering comes around annually and we typically donate about \$ 500.- if we can afford it. Half of the offering will go to an endowment for schooling outside the US – the other half for training for laity across the Dakota's conference.
