We provide **COMPREHENSIVE LEARNING DISABILITIES EVALUATIONS** for children who are experiencing a lack of success in school.

Our program is unique in that every child works with 5 specialists. These specialists work as a team to help you and your child's teachers to better understand how your child learns and to specify your child's medical, educational, social and psychological needs. Our specialists include:

- Neurology
- Neuropsychology
- Oral and Written Language
- Mathematics
- Psychology

Our team approach provides "one-stop shopping" and importantly an integrated understanding of your child that brings together the multiple perspectives of a team of experts.

The Learning Disabilities Program evaluation is appropriate for children who are in the 2nd through 8th grades. Children previously seen in our program may be seen for re-evaluation through the 9th grade.

Our program is not appropriate for children who:

- Are diagnosed with Intellectual Disability
- Are bilingual and not yet educated fully in English
- Have primary sensory or motor disabilities
- Would not be able to participate in a 3-4 hour session because of behavioral or emotional issues.
