RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. This class is open to boys and girls of Madison County and any adjoining county that allows us to show in their Junior Show. They must be 8 years old in third grade prior to Jan. 1 of the year in which they will show or will not be 20 years of age until after Dec. 31 of the year in which they show.
2. All exhibits must be grown in the current year. Seeds or crops must be from the most recent crop year.
3. No containers will be provided. The attractiveness of the container and arrangement of the exhibit is important.
4. Grain must be displayed in clear, glass, quart jars with lids.
5. Vegetables should be displayed on a sturdy paper plate or container. The Fair Association is not responsible for broken, damaged or stolen containers.
6. An exhibitor may make two entries under each lot number.
