

- 1. Rent is due on the 1st of the month and late on the 6th day.
- 2. Eviction moratoriums do not waive your rent obligation.
- 3. Housing authorities cannot waive rent obligations or write off rent payment debt.
- 4. Income changes may result in an adjustment to your rent obligation.
- 5. If your unit has an unresolved maintenance issue, you are still obligated to pay rent. Escrow option is available through the courts.
- 6. You are obligated to pay rent whether or not you live in a licensed or unlicensed unit.
- 7. Repayment agreements are available if you owe a prior balance in rent. Down payments are calculated in accordance with amount owed.
- 8. You must be current on your rent in order to be eligible to transfer to another unit.
- 9. You must be current on your rent in order to return to a redevelopment project.
- 10. You must be current on your rent in order to receive a Housing Choice Voucher.
