Flex Dollars can be added anytime using the GET app, at our main office located in Kaufman Dining Hall, or by contacting us. Flex Dollars expire upon graduation or after 12 months of inactivity.

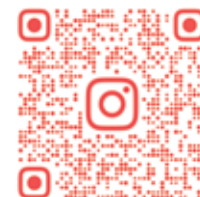
