I HEARD THE BELLS ON CHRISTMAS DAY

In December 1863, during the height of the Civil War, poet Henry Wadsworth Longfellow received news that his son had been wounded in the Battle of New Hope Church. Longfellow had struggled much of his life with depression, and having had lost his wife only two years before, the news of his son's wounds was difficult for him to bear.

On the morning of Christmas, as Longfellow sat down at his desk, the bells of a nearby church began to chime. Longfellow listened, and as he thought about their significance, he wrote these words...

I heard the bells on Christmas Day
Their old familiar carols play
And wild and sweet the words repeat
Of peace on earth, good will to men.

And thought how, as the day had come, The belfries of all Christendom Had rolled along the unbroken song Of peace on earth, good-will to men!

And in despair I bowed my head
There is no peace on earth I said
For hate is strong and mocks the song
Of peace on earth, good will to men.

Then pealed the bells more loud and deep,

God is not dead, nor doth he sleep. The wrong shall fail, the right prevail With peace on earth, good will to men.

This poem was put to music and has been sung by just about everybody. It was Johnny Cash's favorite song.

A NEW YEAR'S RESOLUTION

Charles Lamb said, "New Year's Day is every man's birthday." We're just a few weeks away from changing the calendar, so we've all got a birthday coming up. stage area and the curtains. We were able to install our new electronic sign by the roadside which looks great during the day and at night. We also had a very successful BBQ this year.
