THE OLD OLD STORY 1 PETER 2:2

When comedian Bob Newhart stood in front of a live audience for the first time -- it was at the Tideland Motor Inn in Houston -- he performed the only three comedy routines he had: one about Abe Lincoln, one about a Driving Instructor, and one about the Navy.

The crowd loved him, so as he exited the stage, the manager grabbed him and told him to go back out for an encore. "That's all the material I have," he said. It didn't matter; the crowd was cheering, and the manager wanted him to do an encore.

Newhart went back onstage and waited for the applause to die down. Then he asked them, "Which one do you want to hear again?"

He had three routines; if they wanted to hear more, it could only be more of the same. The story goes that Newhart repeated part of one sketch and got laughs all over again.

Preachers feel this way sometimes, I think -- like we've got only a certain number of messages, and we repeat ourselves too often. I feel this way especially when I'm preaching through a book that addresses the same topic chapter after chapter. I also feel it during December; how many ways are there to talk about Christmas?

In preaching, there are certain themes that I turn to repeatedly. Sometimes it feels as though I am saying what's already been said by countless others countless times. This is OK, to a certain extent. C.S. Lewis wrote in *Mere Christianity* that "people need to be reminded more often than they need to be instructed." Returning to the simple topics of how to pray and have a devotional, the importance of loving others and sharing your faith, accepting God's forgiveness, and forgiving others -- these are things we need to be reminded of again and again.

Peter told his readers, "**Like newborn babes, long for the pure milk of the Word that by it you may grow in respect to salvation.**" (1 Peter 2:2) Milk is food for beginners, but we never get past the need for milk. Neither do we get past our need for the basics of the Christian life.

While it is important for me as your pastor, to strive to always to be fresh in my approach to presenting the gospel, I must also remember that you as the Body of Christ (and me as well) need to hear those same wonderful truths over and over again -- they never lose their power.

May you all have a very merry Christmas and a wonderful 2026!

Still, I must admit there's just something about Christmas as a kid that feels a little different. Kids eagerly await Christmas morning, and that anticipation brings pure joy. I believe the Shepherds felt the same joy when they received the good news from the angel, who said to them, "The savior-yes, the Messiah, the Lord- has been born today in Bethlehem, the city of David! And you will recognize him by this sign: you will find a baby wrapped snugly in strips of cloth, lying in a manger." (Luke 2:11-12 NLT)

I began this article by sharing my childhood Christmas experiences, and I will end with a challenge to you this Christmas. Seasons Greetings everyone! I hope this correspondence finds you all well. On Sunday, November 2nd, we held our annual charge conference after the 10:00 service. A proposed budget for the upcoming year was shared with everyone in attendance and a vote was held and passed for approval., I would like to remind everyone that it is just a proposed budget and will likely change by the end of this year once our finance committee has our final financial giving for this current year.

On Thursday, November 20th, our administrative board held our final meeting of the year. Our Trustees reported that one of our HVAC units had quit working so a new one has been purchased. The cost of this new unit was \$18,500. Our Trustees also reported that we now have our Old Church covered under a new insurance policy. Earlier this year our coverage for the Old Church was dropped unexpectedly, so this is good news knowing that it is now covered again.

Our staff parish relations committee reported that they have met several times with Jason Guyer who is our Presiding Elder for our district within the Global Methodist Church. Reverend Guyer will be helping us find our new Pastor here at Mount Pleasant after Pastor Byron's retirement in February.

In closing, as we wrap up this year we have several members in our Church who have served their time on various committees and will be coming off at the end of the year. I am thankful for each of the individuals who have given their time and shared their talents to help keep our Church up and running. If you know of someone currently serving be sure to thank them for all that they do! We are truly blessed here at Mt. Pleasant to have so many individuals willing to help and serve! I hope you all have a Merry Christmas as we celebrate the birth of our Lord & Savior, Jesus Christ.




