#### BUILDING IN PROGRESS ROMANS 8:29

When I'm in my car driving around Sherrills Ford and the Mooresville area, I can't help noticing all the new building that is going on! Each time I pass a construction project I wonder, "What will that be?". There's no sign out front that says "Future home of 'such and such'" -- just big construction equipment and big piles of supplies and mini-mountains of debris. There's some foundation and some structure, but not much else. Sometime in the future these various sites will begin to look like a grocery store or a housing development or a bank. Right now it's hard to tell.

We need to remember that we build by laying one brick at a time, and sometimes it takes a while for our intended final result to become recognizable. Sometimes our work may feel like just a process of stacking bricks -- and sometimes that's all it may look like to others.

Remember that God knows where he's going with you. He's working from a blueprint, and though you can't see it, he knows what the end result will be. He directs every situation and, if we allow him, works out every detail so that his will can be accomplished in us, just as Paul said:

We know that in everything God works for good with those who love him, who are called according to his purpose. For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, in order that he might be the first-born among brethren. (Romans 8:28-29 RSV)

During those times that all that is visible in your life is a bare structure and some piles of debris, remember that God is working from a blueprint; eventually the pieces will come together for your good and his glory.

### PASTOR KALEB'S KLIPPINGS

Greetings in Christ Jesus,

I pray that you and your family is well. I also pray that you are experiencing the miracle-working power of our Lord and Savior as we prepare to enter the season of Lent. I preached a sermon on following Simon's example in Luke 5:4-11 a few Sundays ago. I mentioned that God is calling us to step out in faith. Although it's been a few weeks, I believe this is still applicable every day. It's hard to believe that Ash Wednesday, which marks the beginning of Lent, is less than a week away. It feels like we just gathered for our Christmas Eve service yesterday.

The season of Lent has always been a favorite season of mine; not because the weather hopefully starts to warm up or anything, but because I am reminded daily in this season of my need for a savior. On Ash Wednesday, we mark our foreheads with ashes to remind ourselves of our human mortality. Genesis 3:19 states, "for you were made from dust, and to dust you shall return." (NLT) This is a beautiful reminder of not only our mortality but also our dependency on the Creator. During Lent, we begin a journey of submission to the Lord. We remind ourselves daily for 40 days that we are humans dependent on our Lord. Often, Lent has been narrowed down to just "giving something up." While this may be true, I want to challenge you as followers of Jesus to step out in faith during this Lenten season. Adopt a new spiritual practice or distance yourself from a harmful habit for 40 days, where you submit yourself to the Lord. Seek His wisdom and pray for what this might look like. Whatever you do, do it for the Love of God and draw close to Him. To paraphrase Numbers 6:24-26:

May the Lord bless you and keep you; may His face shine upon you and be gracious to you; may He turn his face toward you and give you peace during this Lenten season.

# Mt. Pleasant Preschool News

Preschool enrollment will open to the public this month. Some of the classes are already full with a waitlist. If you have not turned in your application and registration fee, your child will not be guaranteed their spot for the upcoming year. The registration fee is \$75.00. We encourage you to take advantage of early registration and save \$25.00. This fee will increase to \$100.00 after June 30th. Enrollment packets may be picked up at the Preschool Office or on our website www.mtpleasantpreschool.com.

We would like to thank **Lake Norman Pediatric Dentistry** for coming to the preschool and discussing proper dental hygiene with the children. They will be visiting us on February 27<sup>th</sup> and March 7<sup>th</sup>.

We will be celebrating **Dr Seuss's birthday the week of March 3**<sup>rd</sup> – **7**<sup>th</sup>. The children will be able to dress each day as follows:

Monday (Thing 1 & Thing 2) Show us your craziest hairstyle

Tuesday (Fox In Socks) Show us your craziest socks Wednesday (Green Eggs & Ham) Wear something green or yellow

Thursday & Friday (Sleep Book) – Wear your favorite pajamas to school

We are now registering for **Summer Preschool**. We have classes in June, July, and August. The Program is offered to children ages 2 - 5. We also have a class for K-2<sup>nd</sup> grade. This is for those FINISHING kindergarten – **second grade.** Classes are Tuesday/Wednesday/ Thursday's. This will allow parents and staff to plan long weekend vacations. The early registration fee will be \$45.00 which is due by May 3<sup>rd</sup>. After May 3<sup>rd</sup>, the registration fee will increase to \$55.00. This fee reserves your child a spot in our Summer Program and helps with the cost of supplies needed. A copy of the summer dates is attached. You have the option of choosing which week's work is best for your schedule. The cost is \$70.00 a week. If you choose to send your child each week, you will receive a \$10 discount for that month. The payment is due on the first day that your child attends preschool each month. We look forward to another fun summer at Mt Pleasant!
