SAFE AI IN ABA

AI can bring efficiency & structure to ABA providers, but without guardrails, it risks HIPAA violations, ethical breaches, & faulty documentation. Use the SAFE method to stay compliant & client - centered.

SCREEN FOR PHI

- Don't enter client names, diagnoses, or session notes into non-HIPAA compliant AI platforms.
- Treat prompts like emails: If it contains PHI, don't share it.

Tip: Create "safe prompt templates" for staff that avoid client identifiers.

APPROVE WITH OVERSIGHT

- Al can assist, but only a BCBA or supervisor approves treatment goals, plans, or parent communication.
- Al does not replace clinical judgment.











FACT-CHECK OUTPUTS

- Al "hallucinates", it can generate false or misleading information.
- Every Al-assisted note or report must be reviewed and corrected by staff.

Tip: Add a checklist step: "Reviewed for accuracy + compliance" before submitting.

EDUCATE STAFF

- Staff should know what AI can and cannot be used for.
- Provide ongoing training on HIPAA, BACB ethics, and safe Al practices.

Tip: Build a simple AI policy and hold an annual refresher training.
