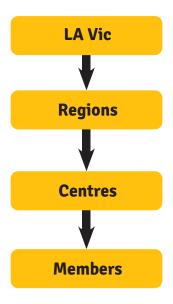
Little Athletics Victoria

Little Athletics Victoria is a children's athletics program for 5 year olds to 17 year olds. Athletes participate in running (sprinting, hurdles, endurance running), jumping (long jump, high jump, triple jump) and throwing (discus, shot put, javelin).

There are almost 100 Little Athletics Centres in Victoria, which are grouped into 7 regions: Eastern Metro, Gippsland Country, Northern Country, Northern Metro, Southern Metro, Western Country and Western Metro.

Swan Hill Little Athletics Centre is part of the Western Country Region which includes centres such as Ararat, Ballarat, Beaufort and District, Buninyong, Camperdown, Casterton, Cohuna, Colac, Edenhope, Hamilton, Horsham, Kerang, Lake Bolac and District, Maryborough, Port Fairy, Portland, Stawell and Warrnambool.

Any participation in State level athletics will first be within the Western Country Region before progressing to State Championships against athletes who have qualified from the other various regions.

Proof of birth must be provided for all new registations or upon request from the Centre, where it hasn't been marked as sighted prior.

Important: Athletes born in 2021 must have turned 5 before registering (these new U6 athletes will repeat U6 in the next calendar season 2026/27)

Registration - inclusions and insurance

All registrations and payment must be completed online at www.lavic.com.au. Registration will only be finalised on payment of the membership fee and the completion of LAVic registration online. There is no paper based registration available.

Once you are registered, you become a member of the Swan Hill Little Athletics Club (SHLAC), Little Athletics Victoria (LAVic) and Little Athletics Australia (LAA). Parents of members, by signing the register when they register their children, also become members.

Registration

All members are fully insured through our affiliation with LAVic and are able to participate in any LAVic or LAA event anywhere in Australia. The insurance coverage includes personal accident at the centre, liability insurance for coaches and centre executive members and public liability.

If you are travelling for the weekend and cannot participate at our regular Friday night competition, membership allows your athlete to participate at another centre. Points can be submitted to our club registrar on your return and uploaded to your aggregate points.

Registration also allows your athlete to compete in open days, regionals and in cross country competitions through LAVic, and be eligible for selection for State Championship heats and finals.

These events will be advertised through our Facebook page, via ResultsHQ and listed in the Calendar of Events section of this handbook.

Registration with Swan Hill Little Athletics includes your athlete's participation in both the summer track and field competition, and the winter cross country season.

Registration fees

The registration fee for the 2025/26 season is \$110 per athlete. This fee is comprised of two parts:

- An LAVic fee that covers insurance and the running of LAVic, which is \$89.
- SHLAC fee for the running of Swan Hill Little Athletics Centre, which is \$21.

Fees for just the cross country winter competition are \$60 per athlete. This comprises \$55 in LAVic fees and \$5 in SHLAC fees.

We aim to keep the centre fee as low as we can to ensure little athletics is a sport open to children from all backgrounds.

Registration

New athletes New athletes considering joining our club can register as trial athletes.

New members can use their two free 'trial weeks' within the first 4 weeks of the season, and must then pay their membership fees following the second week of trial attendance (if they wish to join). Trial athletes are fully covered by the national insurance program entered into by Little Athletics Australia Ltd ('LAA') for the 28-day period of the Trial Athlete Offer.

The points system (for club awards) will not be counted until an athlete is fully registered and paid.

Existing and returning members

For existing members renewing their registration, fees are due on registration. The points systems will not start until membership fees are fully paid.

Uniform and patches

Swan Hill Little Athletics Centre was formed in 1968 and was the 25th Centre to register with the Victorian Little Athletics Association (VLAA). This is the reason our uniform displays the number 25.

Black shorts and the red top have been the uniform at our Centre and at carnivals, state and regional competitions since 1968.

Club singlets, t-shirts and crop tops are available for purchase. Black training polo t-shirts and hoodies are also available and are a great option for wearing

when not competing.

Uniforms can be purchased online during athlete registration or from the canteen.



What to wear to local club competition

Athletes MUST wear the provided Commonwealth Bank registration chest patch while participating in all Centre activities. This is a safety procedure and sponsorship requirement.

Wearing a chest patch allows our officials and the parents of other athletes to quickly know the athlete's name and age group. In case of accident or emergency, athletes' names can be accessed quickly.

A chest patch will be provided to you on your first night of competition for the season. The patch needs to be pinned to the front of the athlete's top each week. **Please keep this patch and bring it along each week.**

Athletes without a chest patch may be prevented from competing as they are in breach of the LAVic Competitive Members' membership requirements.

Uniform is optional on club competition nights, but athletes must wear appropriate footwear (spikes may be worn in accordance with LAVic rules) and sun protection, including a hat and sunscreen.



What to wear to open days, regionals and state competition

Club singlets and plain black shorts MUST be worn when competing at open days or regional and state events. Centre singlets are available on loan if you are attending open days, state or regional competition.

All centre uniforms singlets, tees and crops MUST have a small Coles patch attached above the LAVic logo - this is a state requirement.

Athletes must wear appropriate footwear (spikes may be worn in accordance with LAVic rules) and sun protection, including a hat and sunscreen. The chest patch must also be worn, as per above.

Results HQ

After every athletics or cross country event, your athlete's results will be uploaded to LAVic's results platform, Results HQ. To track results, login to https://resultshq.com.au/login



Your username will be the email address used for registration. Note that any personal bests (PBs) recorded at Open Days or Carnivals will not count towards the Swan Hill Little Athletics end of summer athletics competition awards.



Inclusivity

Little athletics develops children of ALL abilities, providing a warm and inclusive environment for all young people to be their best. We aim to provide an inclusive environment in which barriers to involvement are removed and all people feel welcome and comfortable to participate.

If your athlete requires modifications to our standard program to allow them to compete, please contact the Committee. We can work to see whether modifications may need to or can be made to suit the requirements of your child.

Our summer Season

Swan Hill Little Athletics Centre runs a weekly summer athletics program from October to March with a break over the summer school holidays.

Competition is held every Friday night at 5pm at the Ken Harrison Sporting Complex. Families should gather in front of the clubrooms by that time.

The event schedule for that competition day will be on display on the noticeboard along with any other information for families.

Before competition starts, athletes will be taken through a warm-up on the oval. After warm-up, athletes will return to the clubhouse for announcements and the announcement of PB awards. Various age groups will then be directed to their first event. Competition generally finishes around 6.30pm.

Every age group competes in 4 different events per week.





If a competition night is cancelled due to wet weather or extreme heat, the cancellation will be advertised via our Facebook page.

How to get involved

There are numerous ways for parents / carers and other volunteers to get involved and help to run Swan Hill Little Athletics Centre. We simply cannot function without parents' input.

- **Setting up and packing up equipment:** At 3.30pm on a Friday night, the committee meets to start setting up for the night's athletics program. If you can make it to Ken Harrison Reserve earlier, we'd love to have your help.
- **Age group helper:** Each age group benefits from a helper who will guide the group from event to event.
- Measurer: Holding a measuring tape and / or measuring jumps or throws.
 Someone will show you where to measure from.
- **Recording:** Each throwing or jumping event has a folder for recording each child's three attempts. These records will be uploaded by the Registrar following competition night to ResultsHQ.
- Barbecue or canteen: The canteen is open every competition night and is a
 great place to help out of the sun. A barbecue is cooked several times during
 summer competition and cooks are greatly needed.
- Raking over the jumping pits: Following each jump, the pits need to be raked.
- **Coaching:** We'd welcome any ex-athletes with any expertise in this area. Jump in and help, or ask a committee member where to start!

Other jobs arise from time to time. Please ask us or simply jump in and help out!

Improve your own skills!

LAVic's Introduction to Teaching Little Athletics Skills (ITLAS) is available online. Parents are encouraged to take part, to learn the basics of each event and how to help our athletes. Go to **littleathleticselearning.com.au**.

This is a great resource for all parents to help build your skills to help on a Friday night.

Our summer Season

Recording

Parents and helpers are needed to record distances in the jumping events (long jump and triple jump) and the throwing events (shot put, discus and javelin).

The same principles are followed for each event, where each throw or jump is recorded and the best of three attempts carried across at the end of the event. Any no-qualifying throw or jump is recorded as an X.

For example:

Name	1 st Attempt	2 nd Attempt	3 rd Attempt	Best
Athlete 1	4.55	Χ	4.32	4.55
Athlete 2	1.25	1.72	2.05	2.05
Athlete 3	3.33	Χ	X	3.33

High jump is slightly different. Each jump for a particular height is recorded with:

X for a failed attempt

O for a cleared jump

- for an athlete who did not jump

Each athlete gets three attempts at a height. After the third failed attempt, the athlete is finished with the event.

Recognising achievements

One of the main aims of Little Athletics is to encourage athletes to improve their skills and performances through participation in the summer weekly program.

Athletes are rewarded for participation and personal improvement through an aggregate points system that is fair to all athletes, regardless of ability.

At the end of the summer season, an awards night will be held and the following awards announced.

Certificates of achievement

At the end of the season, all athletes will receive a Certificate of Achievement detailing their personal best performances (PBs), along with a participation medals. To be eligible for a participation medal, athletes must participate in at least 8 nights in the season - discounting washouts or heat affected nights.

Age group trophies

This is calculated on an aggregated points system throughout the summer season. The points are awarded for:

Attendance		1pt
Place	1st 2nd 3rd 4th 5th 6th or more	10pts 8pts 6pts 4pts 2pts 1pt
PBs	Equal PB Better PB	2pts 5pts
Centre Record	Equal record Better record	5pts 10pts



In each age group, trophies are awarded to the athletes who have accumulated the most aggregate points.



Our Summer Season

Most personal bests

These awards are presented to the girl and boy who achieved the most personal bests.

Best at States

Awarded for the best performance by a boy and a girl at the State Championships. (Determined by the highest ranked placing ie. 1 gold medal is better than 2 silver medals).

Committee award

Awarded to the athlete or committee member who best fits the criteria of the "Little Athletes Code of Conduct"

Best on Track & Field

Awarded to the athletes who achieved the most points in either the track or the field for the season.



Regional and State Track and Field Championships

By participating in four weeks of Swan Hill Little Athletics Centre sanctioned competition as a fully paid member, all athletes from U9 to U17 qualify to compete in the Regional Track & Field Championships. These are usually held in February each year, and venues vary. To enter, register and pay via the LAVic website. Athletes are invited to choose up to 5 events to participate in.

Athletes must qualify at the Regional Track & Field Championships to progress to the State Track & Field Championships. Swan Hill belongs to the Western Country Region.

We will notify you if your athlete has qualified for progression. There is no direct qualifying for the State Championship without attending the Regionals.

Parents of competing athletes at either of these championships are required to provide assistance with duties that are allocated to our club. If these duties are not performed, our athletes will be disadvantaged. It is also expected that the athletes, parents and spectators behave according to the code of conduct outlined in this handbook.



Open Days

Once an athlete has become a fully paid member, they can compete at any Open Day or carnival of other Little Athletics Clubs. Open Days will be advertised via our Facebook page and emails, or you can check the Victorian Little Athletics website at https://lavic.com.au/

Registration and entry fees are the responisibility of individual families. You need to wear your centre uniform with the LAVic name patch you received upon registering.

In the past, Swan Hill Little Athletics Centre has had athletes compete at the Open Days / Carnivals at Finley, Deniliquin, Horsham, Wodonga, Albury, Griffith, Maryborough, Seaford and Coburg.

Junior Development Squad

The Little Athletics Victoria Junior Development Squad (JDS) is a program aimed at developing an athlete's skill and technical competencies through coaching and training sessions with Victoria's leading coaches. The JDS is open to athletes in the U12-U17 age groups and is scheduled during the summer season.

Athletes can qualify for the JDS by achieving athletic results better than the minimum performance criteria in 2 qualifying performances. Qualifying performances can be achieved during SHLA centre competition, Open Days, Regional or State Events.

The program consists of coaching days, coaching camp, education sessions, information sessions for parents and a presentation ceremony at completion. Most of these sessions are held in Melbourne.

Cross Country

During the winter season (April to August), cross country events are on either Friday afternoon or Sunday morning (TBC). These events will be advertised on our Facebook page, and will be located at Riverside Park, Milloo Wetlands or Tower Hill Park.

Your yearly membership covers both the summer and winter competitions. If an athlete only wants to compete in cross country, registration fees for 2026 will be set in late March. All registrations and payment must be completed online at www.lavic.com.au.

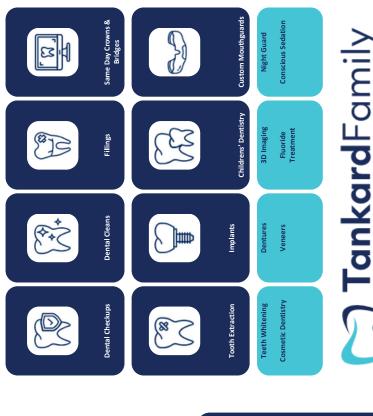

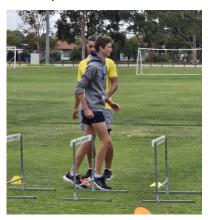
Our centre ran an online fundraising campaign, contributing more than \$2500 towards their trip – what a great little athletics community we have!

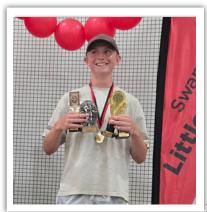

Centre Policies

Little Athletics understands there are various factors that can affect a little athlete and as a result has adopted the following policies:

Safety The committee will ensure the safety of activities by checking equipment and the track locations before events.

Healthy food choice policy The Centre will ensure that a variety of healthy food choices are available after competition and various activities.

Smoke free policy

All areas under the Centre's venues are to be smoke free—including clubrooms, change rooms, toilet blocks, spectator and competition areas. Centres will place 'No Smoking' signs in prominent positions around the venues.

Sun protection policy

Centres are encouraged to provide shade structures at venues and make SPF15+ or higher sunscreen available. Athletes and Officials are advised to wear hats and carry drink bottles to events.

Responsible alcohol management

There is to be no sale or consumption of alcohol during the conduct of any Little Athletics events. Where alcohol is consumed at functions the Centre will comply with Liquor Licensing Victoria regulations.



Working with Children Check The "Working with Children Act 2005" requires adults that work with children or engaged in volunteer roles involving children (under 18 years of age) get a Working with Children Check (WWC). The following people volunteering with

Swan Hill Little Athletics Centre are required to have their WWC Check:

- Committee members
- Coaches and assistant coaches
- Officials at State and Region level (not parent helpers who's child is participating on the day)
- Volunteers without children registered at the Centre
- First aid personnel

Parents who have a child registered at the centre are exempt from the WWC check unless they fall under the categories above or those additionally listed on the LAVic website. Parents, grandparents or carers who are involved in the SHLAC can provide a copy of their WWC to add to our Club Register. It is free to get a WWC Check for volunteers and forms can be downloaded online.

Little Athletics Swan Hill endorses the Codes of Conduct as set out by Little Athletics Victoria. Please take time to read the information included in the booklet. All members must comply with the Code of Conduct and appropriate action may be taken in case of any breaches of the Code of Conduct. Little Athletics Victoria will ensure that all athletes, coaches, spectators, parents, officials and administrators are not prone to sexual abuse, neglect, physical abuse or emotional abuse.

The following Codes of Behaviour underpin Little Athletics and ensure that all athletes, spectators, officials and volunteers have a very clear understanding of the behaviour that is expected from everyone and to make it clearly understood that breaches of these codes will result in disciplinary action.

Little Athletics Victoria (LAVic) Code of Conduct ('the Code') encourages appropriate standards of behaviour to enable all in Little Athletics to experience a safe, welcoming and inclusive sport.

The Code is closely aligned with Sport & Recreation Victoria's Fair Play Code (2022), and is guided by the five principles of Integrity, Safety, Respect, Fairness and Responsibility.

Responsibilities

Parents / Guardians

Be informed about, abide by, and drive compliance with the Code. Educate children about the importance of demonstrating Code behaviours and model these behaviours at all times. Report a potential breach of the Code in accordance with the Complaints Handling & Dispute Resolution Policy.





Athlete

Ask an adult, such as a parent/quardian, or Centre representative about the Code and abide by the principles. Report a potential breach of the Code to a parent/ guardian or responsible adult.

Coaches, Officials, committee members, volunteers,

Club/Centre/Region/State members

Be informed about, abide by, and drive compliance with the Code. Promote the

Code to all participating in sanctioned LAVic activities, such as competition, training, meetings, social events, communications etc. Report a potential breach of the Code in accordance with the Complaints Handling & Dispute Resolution Policy.

Directors and employees

Be informed about, abide by, and drive compliance with the Code. Promote the code to all participating in sanctioned LAVic activities, such as competition, training, meetings, social events, conferences, communications etc. Report a potential breach of the Code in accordance with the Complaints Handling & Dispute Resolution Policy.

Spectator

Abide by the Code when attending sanctioned (official) Little Athletic activities. Report a potential breach of the Code in accordance with the Complaints Handling & Dispute Resolution Policy.

Principles

The Code of Conduct outlines a set of guiding principles on expected standards of behaviour for every person involved in activities sanctioned by LAVic. All should demonstrate the principles of integrity, respect, responsibility, fairness and safety in everything they do.

Integrity

- Being honest, fair, respectful, trustworthy, reliable, open and transparent in dealings with others.
- Avoiding real or perceived conflicts of interest.
 Striving to earn and sustain a high level of community trust and goodwill.
- Not engaging in, and advocating for the possession of, and use of banned performance enhancing substances or methods, or illicit drugs.
- Not participating in or encouraging of actions that may jeopardise the integrity of Little Athletics including race-fixing, illegal sports betting and other forms of corruption.

Respect

- Treating all involved in activities sanctioned by LAVic in a considerate, objective and courteous manner with proper regard for their rights, dignity and worth.
- Refraining from any form of discrimination, harassment, bullying, abuse, child abuse, intimidation, victimisation or vilification of others, including on the basis of age, race, sex, disability, sexuality, gender identity or religion.
- Recognising and valuing the contribution of all involved in activities sanctioned by Little Athletics Victoria, including volunteer coaches, officials, administrators and volunteers who give up their valuable time to make the sport of athletics possible.

Responsibility

- Considering and accepting the consequences of one's actions and decisions.
- Being a positive role model by displaying self-control, respect, care and diligence towards all involved in sanctioned Little Athletics activities.
- Complying with the Victorian Child Safe Standards (2022).
- Understanding the consequences of Code of Conduct breaches and reporting as appropriate.





Fairness

- Behaving in accordance with policies of the Club, Centre, Region and Little Athletics Victoria.
- Being informed, consistent and impartial, just and reasonable in dealings with others.
- Being a 'good sport' inclusive of encouraging and praising fair play over winning at all costs.
- Ensuring a 'fair go' for all to be involved in sanctioned Little Athletics Victoria activities.

Safety

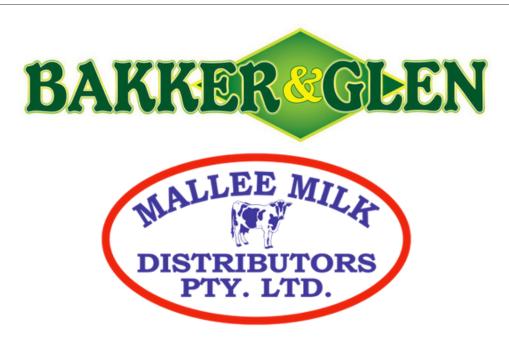
- Providing a safe, welcoming and inclusive environment that prioritises the health, welfare and wellbeing of participants.
