There is only 1 Blog per account. Therefore, the only way to section the posts is by using tags.

Take a look at this blog - <https://artizaninteriors.co.uk/Blog>

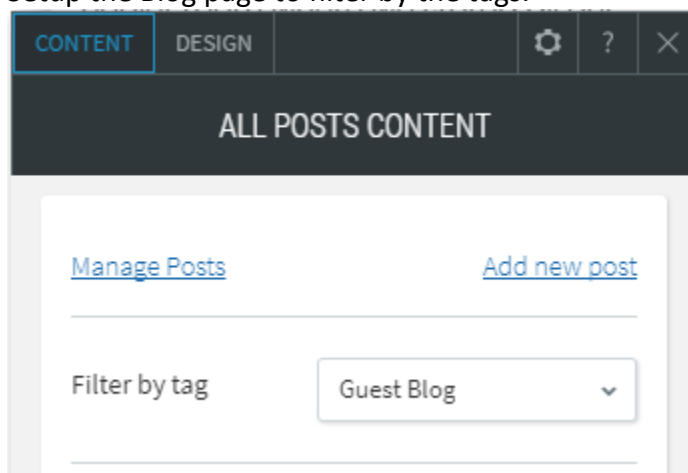
I used “Artizan” as the main tag and “Guest Blog” as another tag. All posts must have a tag to display.

1. Enter the appropriate tag for each post to automatically display in the proper section.



You set the tag by clicking the gear icon next to the edit icon to open Post Settings. Tags field is at the bottom.

2. Republish every post.
3. Setup the Blog page to filter by the tags.

Pure CSS image hover color change effect

This method is based on a CSS property called "filter" which allows you to add effects like blur, contrast, and saturation to html elements, mainly images.

Somebody put together this fantastic tool to generate all the filters you'll need to achieve the appearance of your target color. Just type in the target color's hex code and hit "Compute Filters:"

(note that it states if your icons aren't black to begin with you should add "brightness(0) saturate(100%)" to the beginning of the filters)

Just copy the CSS it generates for you and paste it in your CSS selector for the image hover and you're good to go!
