## Why Do We Crown a Statue of Mary During the Month of May?

The age-old tradition of showing the Blessed Virgin Mary wearing a royal crown stretches through the centuries. The practice of crowning images of the Mother of God came into use in the early fifth century, “since the Council of Ephesus portrayed Mary as Queen and Empress seated upon a royal throne adorned with royal insignia, crowned with the royal diadem and surrounded by the host of angels and saints in heaven.” By the end of the 16th century in the West, “the practice of crowning images of the Blessed Virgin became extensive.”

While the crowning of Mary is an obvious allusion to her queenship, the tradition also has roots in sacred Scripture. In Revelation 12, Mary is described in this way: “A great sign appeared in heaven: a woman clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet and a crown of 12 stars on her head.” May our Blessed Mother intercede on our behalf this spring and grant that we too may share in the fullness of her resplendent grace.

### A Jubilee Invitation: 33 Days to Eucharistic Glory

As the Diocese of Allentown celebrates its 65th Jubilee Year, Bishop Schlert invites every parishioner of Sacred Heart to **join him in a diocesan-wide Eucharistic Consecration** — a journey to deepen our love for Jesus, truly present in the Most Holy Eucharist.

Beginning Tuesday, May 5, we will spend 33 days in prayer with the book, *33 Days to Eucharistic Glory*, by Matthew Kelly, leading to our Consecration on Sunday, June 7, the Solemnity of Corpus Christi. Through the generosity of Dynamic Catholic, the book will be provided free of charge to every parishioner who wishes to take part. Please pick up your copy in the vestibule of the church.

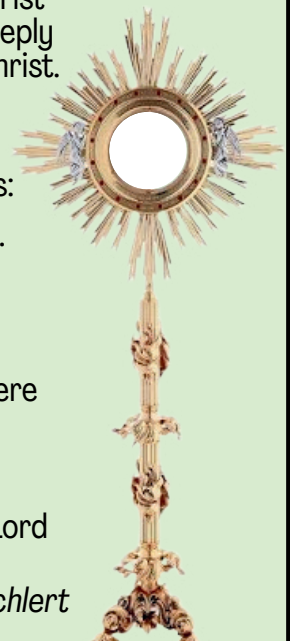
As Catholics, we profess with conviction that the Eucharist is “the source and summit of the Christian life” (CCC 1324). Under the humble appearance of bread and wine, Jesus Christ is truly, really, and substantially present – Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. The more deeply we enter into this mystery, the more profoundly we are transformed by the love of Christ.

As we celebrate the 65th anniversary of the Diocese of Allentown, I am happy to announce a diocesan-wide initiative that will invite the faithful to consecrate themselves to the Holy Eucharist. The consecration will unfold in three distinct phases:

- Total Parish Consecration – May 5 through June 7 – the Solemnity of Corpus Christi.
- College Campuses within the Diocese – Oct. 17 through Nov. 18.
- All Diocesan Schools and Parish Religious Education Programs – Oct. 20 through December 8, the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.

During this 65th Jubilee Year, we are called to renewal in faith and fervor. It is my sincere hope that this Eucharistic Consecration will deepen our communion with the Lord, strengthen the unity of our diocesan family, and bear lasting spiritual fruit. As the patroness of our Cathedral, St. Catharine of Siena reminds us that “Love follows knowledge.” Under her maternal intercession, may our knowledge of the Eucharistic Lord increase, and through that knowledge, may our love be ever more fully enkindled.

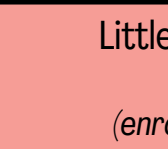

In today's Gospel reading Jesus tells the disciples that He is the way to the Father in Heaven.

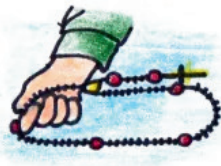

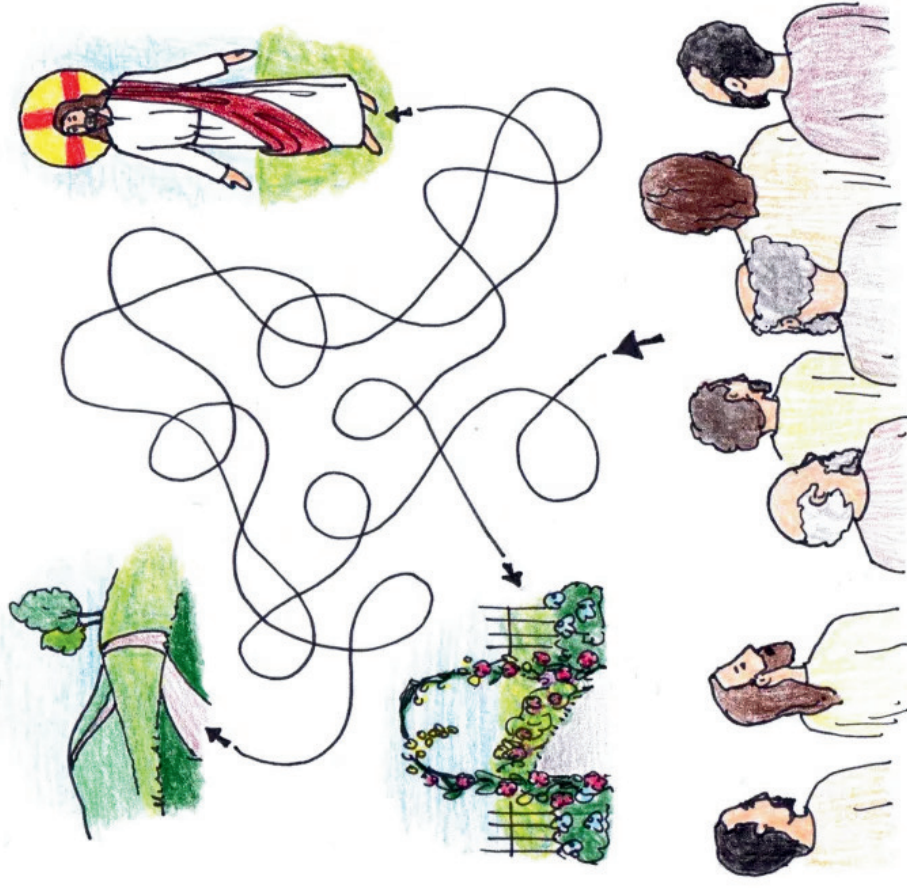

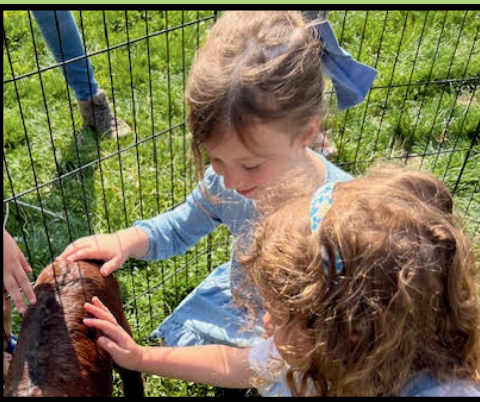
