





## Oplatki: A Christmas Tradition

An Eastern European tradition, oplatki are white wafers imprinted with Nativity scenes. The custom is for family members to gather around the Christmas Eve table. The eldest will break off a piece of the oplatki wafer and pass it to another family member while offering a blessing for that person. The sharing of the oplatki is an expression of unconditional love and forgiveness.

The tradition's resemblance to the Eucharistic meal is no coincidence. Just as we share in the Eucharist as one family in Christ and receive Christ's love through the Eucharist, the oplatki allows for the members of a family to come together and share the love they have for one another. This symbolism is deepened by the fact that the name of the town where Jesus Christ was born, Bethlehem, means "House of Bread." The oplatki tradition is an especially beautiful way to celebrate the charity and unity that are characteristic of the Christmas season.



Oplatki may be purchased at the rectory. One package of three wafers is \$3.00. Two packages of three wafers are \$5.00.



# The St. Theresa Parish Advent Giving Tree

Our Advent Giving Tree is an Advent symbol portraying the spiritual heritage of Jesus as suggested by Isaiah's prophecy: "There shall come forth a shoot from the stump of Jesse." We, too, are that shoot as we claim our baptismal heritage. How might God be calling us to share our gifts this year? One way is to help our local Catholic Charities which provides for women who are experiencing crisis pregnancies in the Diocese of Allentown.

Just remove a tag from the Giving Tree and either (1) purchase the designated gift card at the rectory, or (2) place your payment and gift tag in an envelope marked "Giving Tree" and drop it in the collection basket. 
