"Repent, for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand." As we enter the second Sunday of Advent, we hear the strong & familiar voice of John the Baptist calling out in the wilderness: "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand." His words may sound challenging, but at their heart they are words of hope. John is not scolding us; he is waking us up from our spiritual slumber as I mentioned last Sunday. John is reminding us that God is closer to us than we imagine, ready to renew our lives and our world provided we are open to Him.

Advent is the season when the Church lovingly invites us to pause, breathe, & look honestly at our hearts. John's message is not about dwelling on our failures but about rediscovering the beauty of God's mercy. To repent simply means to turn back, to realign our steps with the One who walks with us, to open the door for God's grace to enter & heal. It is about making room for Him in our hearts as we reflected last Sunday.

For us as a parish family, this call takes on special meaning today. In a world often filled with hurried schedules, heavy news, & growing divisions, repentance becomes an act of courage & hope. It means:

- ⇒ Turning toward God in the middle of our daily busyness & allowing His peace to settle our hearts. Can we spend 5-10 minutes daily quietly in His presence?
- ⇒ Choosing forgiveness & understanding, especially in our homes, families, & community. Often, we are too quick to judge & condemn.
- ⇒ Letting go of what burdens us—old hurts, unhelpful habits, harsh words, or anything that dims the light of Christ within us.
- ⇒ Becoming signs of the Kingdom in little ways, through our kindness, patience, generosity, & small acts of love that brighten the lives of others. We are His messengers!

The good news is this: God is already near. The Kingdom is already unfolding in every act of goodness, every moment of grace, every sincere step we take toward Him. Advent reminds us that God meets us in our real, ordinary lives & gently leads us into something new.

As we light the second candle of the Advent wreath, may its growing flame remind us that Christ comes not only to the world, but to each of us personally. This week, may we hear John's voice not as a warning, but as an invitation, a call to make room for the Lord who desires to bring healing, joy, & renewal to our hearts, our homes, & our parish community.
