Now, I don't share this story for pity, but I find that a lot of women are able to relate to this story. They feel trapped, they feel lost, they are consumed by fear and anxiety, they want to grow but they don't know how, they want to love themselves, but they don't know where to begin.

*I was there, I see these women because I was there.* 

The constant people pleasing, the constant worry, the consistent thoughts of never being enough, and feeling the weight of unrealistic expectations.

As I started my own healing journey, I knew that I wanted to help women who were like me. I wa<mark>nted</mark> to giv<mark>e women hope</mark> and h<mark>elp</mark> the<mark>m get</mark> out o<mark>f t</mark>heir own <mark>wa</mark>y and start living a life they loved. I wanted to teach them skills to learn to love themselves; to fill their heart and soul first, so that they can continue to give to others.

That's why I started my business. That's why I became certified in Reiki, Life Coaching and meditation.

Now, I get to help women who are struggling to calm their thoughts, struggling to love themselves and to bring peace and acceptance into their hearts and their minds by teaching them personalized strategies to heal their hearts, minds and souls.

I have been blessed to help over a hundred women change the stories they tell themselves. Women are setting boundaries, owning their emotions, stepping into their power and healing their lives with my one-on-one coaching and group coaching programs.


