



CHRIST CHURCH MUSIC AND FINE ARTS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The following information will be used in the selection process for both scholarships listed below. Please check the scholarship for which you are applying. "Music and Fine Arts" is defined as any of the following programs: Music, Art, Drama and Dance.

() **Music & Fine Arts Involvement Scholarship:** This scholarship was initially established in 1998 by a member of Christ Church. A scholarship may be awarded each semester to a fulltime (12 hours) college student in any major who has participated in 80% of his/her chosen activity of the Music and Fine Arts program of Christ Church and who continues participating in some area of Music and Fine Arts through his/her college years, either at college, at Christ Church, or at a church in the community where he/she is going to college. Participation must be documented by the music director of the church in which they are participating. Depending upon availability of funds, an award of up to \$3,000 may be awarded per scholarship each semester for college students in any major. Only one scholarship will be awarded each semester, fall and spring.

() **Carolyn Braswell Higher Education Scholarship:** Carolyn and Eddie Braswell were charter members of Christ Church. The first choir practices for the new church were held in their home. Carolyn was a faithful member of the Sanctuary Choir, Jubilate and served for several years as the pianist for the 9:30 a.m. church service. Carolyn not only was a music ministry participant, but she and Eddie were faithful and dedicated participants in most facets of this church. This scholarship, which was established in 2012, is granted to a full-time graduate or undergraduate student seeking a Music/Fine Arts-related degree, who has participated in 80% of his/her chosen activity of the Music and Fine Arts program of Christ Church. Scholarship may or may not be awarded each semester depending upon availability of funds and the quality of applications. Up to \$1,000 may be awarded each semester.
