



Our park is privately owned and consists of 22 acres of natural flora and fauna. Our aim is to provide a relaxed and peaceful environment where families can get together for a campfire (weather permitting) and tourists can base themselves to explore The Coorong National Park, Fleurieu Peninsula & Adelaide Hills. We are the closest park to the Murray Mouth (where the River Murray meets the Southern Ocean. We like to think of our park as a relaxed campground with some facilities rather than a tourist park with all the bells and whistles (and the price tag!)

Facilities

Shop/office. Fully licensed with Beer, Wine, Spirits, Ice-cream, Gas, Ice, Bait, Lollies, Chips, Coffee, and Giftware. Fishing rods and cockle gear is available for hire. If the office is closed an after-hours number is in the office window for late check ins, bookings, and urgent matters.

Large Swimming Pool open from 1st November-31st March each year. Toddlers pool is also available for under 5-year-olds. ALL CHILDREN UNDER 12 MUST BE SUPERVISED BY AN ADULT, NO GLASS ALLOWED IN POOL AREA.

A \$50 charge will be incurred by the site holder if staff are required to attend to remove children.

Site check in time is 11am unless a day pass is organized prior to 11am on the day of departure,

Cabin check in time 2pm and check out time is 10am unless by prior arrangement a later checkout is confirmed. Please return all keys to the office. There is a 10km speed limit in the park at all times. No warnings will be given. Anyone doing over the 10km will not be permitted to have their car in the park grounds and further breaches of this rule will see an eviction of all people at that site with no refunds given.

We want everyone to enjoy themselves, so please keep the noise to a minimum after 10pm. (no music) If staff are required to attend at the request of other site holders a \$100 fee will be charged to your credit card.

All vans must registered and towable.

Pets **UNDER 10KGs** are welcome on Powered and Unpowered sites but must be always kept on a lead. Failure to do so will result in eviction. Please carry bags and clean up after your dog so we can keep our park pet friendly. Bags can be provided at the office upon request. All cabins are non-smoking and no dogs. Breaching this will incur a \$200 housekeeping fee that will be charged to your credit card.

Change for the laundry can be obtained at the office.

RED taps are river water and are **NOT FOR DRINKING**.

The park is on mains water that is held in a tank before being distributed. Boxed and Bottled water is available for purchase from the shop.

Fire regulations from 30th November to 1st May total fire ban (subject to change) During the rest of the year fire drums are permitted. We can supply drums, wood, and extinguishers. Generators are not permitted.

The BBQ area and camp kitchen are available for everyone.

In an emergency such as bushfire please evacuate the park to the assembly point at the river at our jetty. In the case of flood, the evacuation point is the shop.

Visitors to the park must sign in. Are the responsibility of the booked guest and any damage caused or fees created will be charged to the guest. Visitors must sign in and for insurance purposes a small fee will be charged for the use of the swimming pool.
