1. Prioritize Kingdom _____ Over Earthly

“Sell your possessions and give to those in need. This will store up treasure for you in heaven! And the purses of heaven never get old or develop holes.”

2. Prioritize Presence over _____

“Martha was distracted by the big dinner she was preparing. She came to Jesus and said, ‘Lord, doesn’t it seem unfair to you that my sister just sits here while I do all the work? Tell her to come and help me.’” Luke 10:40 (NLT), Luke 39, 41-42

3. Prioritize Compassion over _____

“³¹By chance a priest came along. But when he saw the man lying there, he crossed to the other side of the road and passed him by. ³²A Temple assistant walked over and looked at him lying there, but he also passed by on the other side. ³³“Then a despised Samaritan came along, and when he saw the man, he felt compassion for him.” Luke 10:31-33 (NLT)

4. Prioritize Simplicity over _____

“Jesus took Peter and the two brothers, James and John, and led them up a high mountain to be alone. ²As the men watched, Jesus’ appearance was transformed so that His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became as white as light.” Matthew 17:1-2 (NLT), Luke 16:10

5. Prioritize Repentance over _____

“Jesus told them this story: A man had two sons. ¹²The younger son told his father, ‘I want my share of your estate now before you die.’ So his father agreed to divide his wealth between his sons.¹³A few days later this younger son packed all his belongings and moved to a distant land.” Luke 15:11-13 (NLT), Luke 15:24
