

The Stress-Free Cruise Packing Checklist by Pap Paws Travel & Tours

Section A: The Essentials (Checked items)

- Passport / Birth Certificate (required for closed-loop cruises)
- Cruise Booking Confirmation / Documents
- Medication (in original containers, carried on)
- Driver's License / ID
- Credit Cards / Small Amount of Cash
- **Crucial Non-Clothing Items:** Phone Charger, Portable Power Bank, Sunglasses, Small Backpack (for excursions).

Section B: Cabin & Comfort (The Pap Paws Secret Weapons)

- **Magnetic Hooks:** Essential for hanging bags, hats, and lanyards (metal walls are everywhere!).
- **Over-the-Door Shoe Organizer:** Instantly creates storage for shoes, toiletries, and small items.
- **Power Strip / USB Hub (Non-Surge Protected):** *Cruises prohibit surge protectors!* Use a safe strip to charge all devices.
- Travel Alarm Clock (if you don't use your phone).
- Highlighter (for marking daily activity schedules).

Formal Night	1 Formal Dress / Suit or Tuxedo Rental	1 Formal Dress / Suit or Tuxedo Rental
Footwear	Sandals, Sneakers (for gym/excursions), Water Shoes	Waterproof Boots, Comfortable Walking Shoes, Slippers for Cabin
