Dear Parishioners,

Great news. As of October 5, we have surpassed our DDF goal for 2025. The goal was \$40,300 but we collected \$54,560, exceeding the goal by 135%. A sincere thanks to those who gave in support of our diocese and our parish. Please keep in mind 100% of the monies exceeding the goal (currently \$14,260) will go towards the church roof project and other much needed repairs of our buildings. Plus the church roof project may need additional funds for possible needs once the project begins, e.g., damaged/ worn rafters and electrical, etc.

The DDF 2025 campaign will end on December 31, and we would like those parishioners who have not yet contributed to the DDF to do so before year end. And again, 100% of the monies collected now and until the campaign's end will stay with our parish.
