Traditional service, concluding in funeral home or church **\$ 4270**

Minimum services of funeral director and staff and overhead, transfer of remains to funeral home, refrigeration of remains, use of facilities and staff for viewing an unembalmed body, cremation and alternative container.

Direct cremation with Witness Cremation \$ 1650

Minimum services of funeral director and staff and overhead, transfer of remains to funeral home, refrigeration of remains, witness cremation, cremation and alternative container.

Direct cremation \$ 1400 to 1500

Minimum services of funeral director and staff, transfer of remains to funeral home, refrigeration of remains, cremation. If provided, alternative cremation container: \$100.

Direct cremation with container provided by purchaser: \$1400

If you want to arrange for a direct cremation, you can use an alternative cremation container. Alternative cremation containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without outside covering). The containers we provide are fiberboard with wooden base.

Itemized Price List

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods you select. The prices may change in the future as our costs of providing goods and services change.

Basic services of funeral director and staff and overhead **\$ 1425**

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total overall cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is included in the following package offerings – traditional service, graveside service, memorial service, forwarding remains or receiving remains, immediate burial. The fee includes staff and facilities to respond to initial requests for services, arrangements conference with responsible party to determine services selected, and coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties involved with final disposition of the deceased. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs.

Minimum services of funeral director and staff **\$425**

This fee for our minimum services and overhead will be added only to direct cremation.

Embalming **\$ 695**

Except in certain cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Outer Burial Container Price List

Effective March 1, 2024

An **outer burial container** is a receptacle that encloses the casket in the grave and prevents the grave from settling. It is required by most cemeteries. Types of containers include concrete boxes (grave liners) and burial vaults designed to protect from underground water. Vaults may be made of cement, ABS plastic, or steel.

In most areas of the country, no state or local law makes you buy a container to surround the casket in the grave. However, many cemeteries ask that you have such a container so that the grave will not sink in. Either a burial vault or grave liner will satisfy these requirements.

Grave Markers

Grave markers may be made of bronze or stone, such as granite. Raised monuments are generally made of stone. Since each marker is custom made, the design and price will vary depending on your personal choices. In addition to the cost of the marker, there will be a fee to install it at the grave.

Bronze Markers

Bronze markers are flat bronze plates which are normally installed in a concrete base and set at ground level.

Cremation Urns

Effective March 1, 2024

A **cremation urn** is a container which holds the cremated remains following cremation. Urns may be made of many different materials. Depending on your personal preference, all types of urns are appropriate regardless of design or cost.

Most urns can be engraved with name, dates, or a special tribute.

An **urn vault** is a rigid outer container which surrounds an urn that is to be buried. Many cemeteries require an urn vault for the burial of cremated remains.
