

Installation Instructions

Select a flat, debris-free area near your pool to lay out the Bladder Buddy bag. Ensure the area is large enough for the bag to fully expand when filled.

Carefully unfold the bag and smooth out any creases. Ensure the inlet valve/tap is accessible.

Attach one end of the hosepipe to the outlet of your pool water pump. Secure the connection using hose clamps or fittings to prevent leaks.

Attach the other end of the hosepipe to the Bladder Buddy's inlet valve/tap. Ensure a tight, leak-proof connection.

If your bladder bag has a valve, ensure it's in the open position before starting the pump.

Switch on the pool pump to begin transferring water from the pool into the bladder. Monitor the bladder bag as it fills, ensuring it expands evenly and without overfilling.

Once the bladder is filled, close the valve/tap securely to prevent leakage. Disconnect the hosepipe and remove the pump if no longer needed.

To empty, connect a hose to the bladder's outlet valve/tap. Open the valve and direct the water where needed.

Important Safety Tips ⚠

Do not overfill the bladder – check capacity guidelines.

Ensure the bag is not placed on sharp objects or rough surfaces.

Never leave the pump unattended during filling.

Secure the hose connections to prevent accidental disconnection.
