

## Audio-Visual

- - Wireless lavalier microphone or headset required (preferred: Shure or Sennheiser).
  - A handheld wireless microphone on standby is recommended as backup.
  - For violin: Gregory will provide instrument mic (DPA 4099v with phantom power). Required: Beltpack/wireless system, DI to house sound.
  - For Loop station: Plug in via XLR (DPA 4099v + DAD6001-BC)
- Slides & Computer
  - PowerPoint slides will be provided no later than 48 hours before the event.
  - Slides should be pre-loaded on the venue computer and tested for compatibility.
  - Please do not alter or force into templates, as the design supports narrative delivery.
- Confidence Monitor & Timer
  - A confidence monitor is required, set in Presenter View (showing current + next slide).
  - o A professional digital countdown clock must be positioned at the monitor, visible to the speaker. Hand signals and cue cards are not sufficient.
- Presenter Remote
  - Required: DSAN PerfectCue remote or equivalent. Infrared remotes are not sufficient.
- Stage & Screen
  - Stage must be clear of podiums and obstructions. If a podium is used, it should be placed off to the side.
  - Projection screen should be off-center or elevated above stage, never directly behind where the speaker stands.
