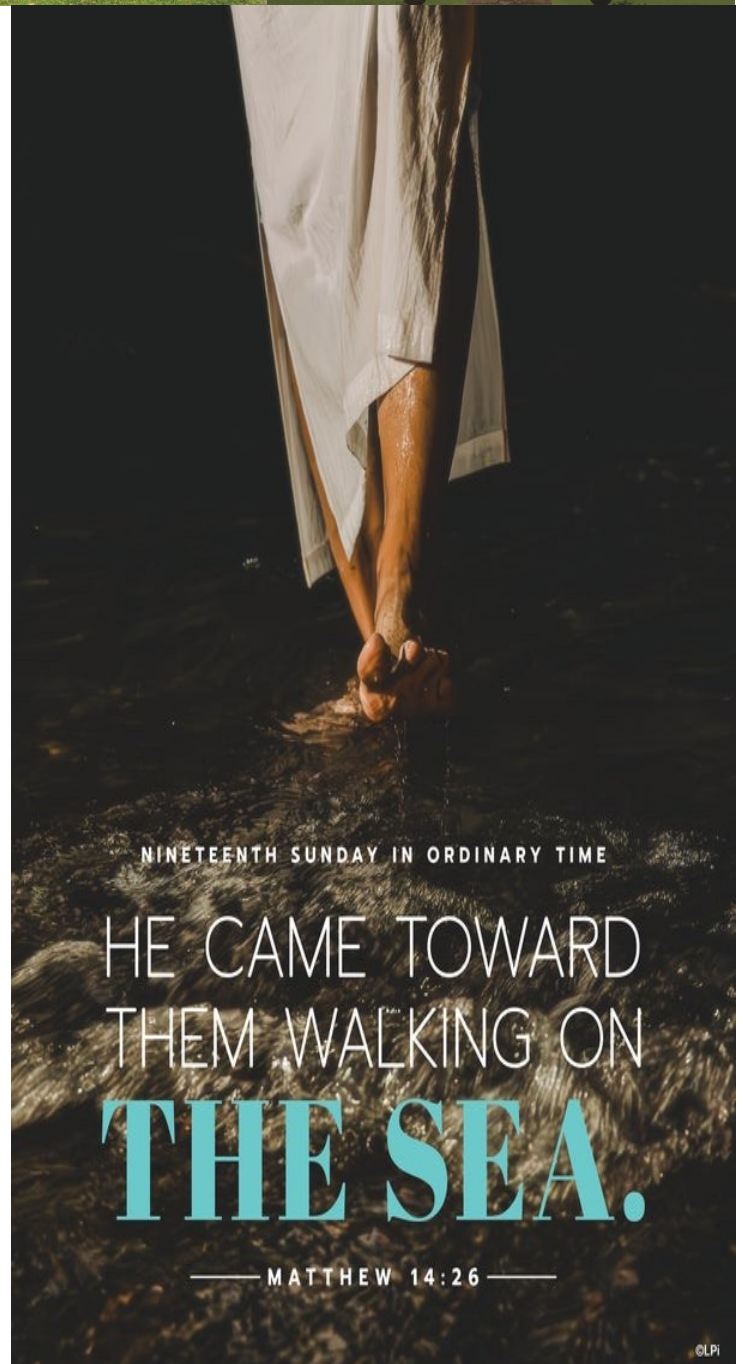

**19th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

"At the mountain of God, Horeb." (1 Kings 19,9) and  
"After doing so, Jesus went up on the mountain by  
himself to pray." (Matthew 14,23)

The first reading and the Gospel share several points in  
common. Elijah and Jesus sought refuge on the mountain;  
Elijah and Peter faced the powers of nature (winds,  
storms, tempests) and found comfort in the divine  
presence. Yet, above all, the question remains: why the  
mountain and the sea?

In the Bible, the mountain is a sacred place—a symbol of  
the divine dwelling and a place of instruction. On Mount  
Moriah, Abraham offered Isaac as a sacrifice (Genesis  
22:2); on Mount Sinai, Moses encountered God for the  
first time (Exodus 3:1); on Mount Tabor, Jesus was  
transfigured before His apostles (Luke 9:28); and King Da-  
vid sang, "I raise my eyes toward the mountains. From  
whence shall come my help?" (Psalm 120) (121:1). It was  
also on a mountain that Jesus sat down to teach the  
crowds (Matthew 5:1). Elijah and Moses sought the pres-  
ence of the Almighty in a place that manifests His power.

The sea, however, is a different matter. It does not have a  
good reputation in the Bible; according to the Book of  
Revelation, it is the lair of the Beast (Revelation 13:1). It  
also symbolizes the difficulties the Church must face. Yet,  
by walking on the water, Jesus sends us a powerful  
message: He is the Lord of all creation. And whoever clings  
to Him—like Peter, for instance—also possesses the power  
to master the forces of nature, reminding us of divine sov-  
ereignty over chaos.

But all of this requires only one thing: faith. It is the foun-  
dation that gives us strength to fulfill God's will—which is  
nothing less than the happiness and well-being of human-  
kind: 'O you of little faith, why did you doubt?' (Matthew  
14:31). This highlights that faith is essential for hope and  
trusting in God's plan.

yet been Confirmed.

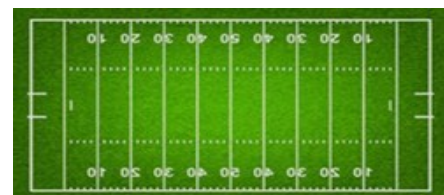

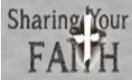
Are you looking for a way to strengthen

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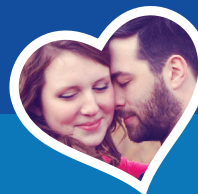
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
