## With Opened Bible Fr. Dimitri

"Just so, your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father."

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus invites us to be and to do as He did: salt and light of the world. To do this, He gives us the perfect example to follow. Acts of compassion inspire admiration in the world: "Just so, your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father." (Matthew 5:16) In this invitation, Jesus should be seen not as one who commands but above all as one who first does what He demands of others. He gave himself up out of love on the cross for his friends. (Cf. John 10:15) Thus, only love and compassion can draw humanity to God.

In the first reading, Isaiah made the same observation.

He exhorted Israel—not to religion, like fasting—but rather to love through works of charity: "Is this not, rather, the fast that I choose: Is it not sharing your bread with the hungry, bringing the afflicted and the homeless into your house; Clothing the naked when you see them, and not turning your back on your own flesh? Then your light shall break forth like the dawn, and your wound shall quickly be healed; Your vindication shall go before you, and the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard. Then you shall call, and the Lord will answer, you shall cry for help, and he will say: "Here I am!" (Isaiah 58:7-9)

This plea emphasized action stemming from love. Jesus would do the same in the discourse on the Last Judgment. Works of mercy are the vectors of true faith: "I was hungry, and you gave me food, I was thirsty, and you gave me drink..." (Matthew 25:35) Indeed, Saint James was right to proclaim that:

"also faith of itself, if it does not have works, is dead. Indeed, someone may say, "You have faith, and I have works." Show me your faith without works, and I will show you my faith by my works." (James 2:17-18)

To be the salt of the earth and the light of the world, we must first know how to love and become signs of compassion in a world without heart or fear of God. Our prayers and beautiful celebrations will not draw the world to God, but our acts of charity, which are different from those of the world, will. Let this inspire you to see your actions as vital to your faith journey, encouraging confidence in your ability to make a difference.

### A Reflection on Prayer

From the moment she entered Carmel, St. Therese of Lisieux's prayer life was often marked by great dryness. During moments of daily silent prayer, after the time of thanksgiving after Mass & during her daily two hours of mental prayer. She humorously evokes this poverty:

"I should be desolate for having slept (for 7 years) during my hours of prayer & my thanksgivings after Holy Communion; well, I am not desolate. I remember that little children are as pleasing to their parents when they are asleep as well as when they are wide awake."

This reflection contains a profound truth. Therese understood that what's most important in prayer is not what I do but what God does. And God never ceases to love me, to communicate his love to me, whether I am awake or asleep. Therese is not self-centered (concerned with making a beautiful prayer that satisfies her) but is receptive to God. This means trusting in God's love for us & not being too preoccupied with ourselves. To pray is to let ourselves be loved in our poverty, in the hope that God will turn that poverty into riches.

Let's do our best to be faithful to prayer & thus express our love of God, but let's never be discouraged by our difficulties & poverties in prayer: they are normal & even beneficial.

Let's make our prayer an act of faith, a humble acceptance of our misery combined with boundless hope in God's goodness & mercy.

This prayer will put us in touch with him, let him act in us, & gradually become the source of all the goods we need in this world.

"Let us hold fast to the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who has promised is faithful." Letter to the Hebrews (10:23).
