








### Terra Fields

# Gege Kimball: Tales of Travel, Laughter & a Life Well-Lived



If you're looking for stories, adventures, and a dash of sass, just pull up a chair next to Sandra "Gege" Kimball. Born and raised in Columbia, Gege grew up in a lively household where her mother—fun, spunky, and hardworking—set the tone for a life well-lived. With her

mom's busy career, Gege's days were filled with the company of a full-time nanny, a house full of friends (thanks to being an only child who never met a stranger), and a steady parade of pets. Her very first dog, a cocker spaniel from her dad, started a lifelong love of animals, and weekends at the family lake house guickly became a tradition for friends and family alike.

Gege graduated from Columbia College, but her most memorable encounter in those days might just be the day she met her future husband, Guy. Picture this: Gege in her orange Comet convertible at Doug Broome's Drive-In, when Guy strolls over with the classic line, "Hi, Blondie!" Turns out, it was the perfect icebreaker. They married in 1968. Gege still laughs about their early days together—especially the time she bounced a check, and Guy promptly separated their bank accounts (and, to this day, she jokes he never let her near the checkbook again).

Both Gege and Guy earned their master's degrees at USC-hers in social work, his in engineering—and built a life full of purpose and compassion. Gege spent two decades working at the state mental hospital in the men's ward (she'll tell you with a grin that the women's ward was just too mean!), and she was a fierce advocate for abused children. Together, she and Guy supported causes close to their hearts: wildlife, nature, and especially the safety of sea turtles at Hunting Island.

But Gege's real specialty? Adventure. Whether they were behind the wheel of their VW Bus or their Mercedes B-Class Van, Gege and Guy covered every state in the U.S.—Alaska and Hawaii included. Their passports filled up with stamps from all over South America: Argentina, Brazil, Chile, Ecuador, Colombia, Peru, Venezuela, and more. They explored Costa Rica, made annual road trips to Mexico for Cinco de Mayo, sipped drinks at the Ice Bar in Antarctica, swapped stories with friends in British Columbia, and even watched as Guy climbed Mt. Fuji in Japan. Of all their travels, Alaska holds a special place in their hearts.

Gege's life is one big collection of laughter, love, and memories made on the road. We're so happy to have her in our community—her stories (and her spirit!) make every day a little brighter.
