The Laying In Ceremony, at Return Home, allows families to bid their loved ones farewell in person or virtually while also adorning them with items that show love and celebrate their memory
Natural Organic Reduction utilizes the body's own naturally occurring microbes to gently transform remains into nutrient-rich soil. The process is conducted in individual vessels and takes approximately 60-90 days to complete.

The resulting soil can then be returned home or donated to a Woodland property in Kent, WA to aid in the restoration of a Washington Forrest.

Return Home is the reduction/terramation center that we use. Located in Washington, they use reduction/terramation as an earth-friendly, natural alternative.
