



COACH CODE OF CONDUCT

Our organization is committed to the principles of positive coaching and against a “win-at-all-cost” mentality. It is of the utmost importance to NVA Sports that our volunteer coaches are coaching all athletes respectfully and that they strive to develop not only their game skills but their character and the confidence in themselves they need to go into the World.

Volunteer Coaches with NVA Sports will...

- Place the emotional and physical well being of their athletes ahead of their personal desire to win.
- Treat each player as an individual and expect age appropriate skills from all their athletes.
- Do their best to provide a safe playing situation for all of their athletes.
- Lead by example in demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all of their athletes on and off the field.
- Respect the referees and their decisions.
- Treat parents and spectators with the same respect they would like from them.
- Remember that they are a volunteer coach in a recreational league and that the game is for children and not adults.
- Be knowledgeable in the rules of each sport that they coach and will teach these rules to my players. Coaches will not teach rules for a different sport than they are coaching (ex. how to tackle while coaching flag football).
- Understand that if they do not live up to this Code of Conduct they will be banned from participating in any NVA Sports activities for a period determined by the staff.
