Our staff worked diligently ahead of our recent winter weather to prevent as much impact on our club as possible. This included work on the golf course that began in the spring and summer months to protect our Bermuda grass that has been impacted in previous years. We are hopeful that all of these additional preparations, along with the planning in the days before this winter weather, will insure transition to spring with limited impact to our turf conditions. Other preparations limited damage to the clubhouse, pool complex, and golf course pipes. Thank you to all the staff for their hard work leading up, during, and after this event.

The back nine restroom is moving along with the completion expected in March, and we are excited for everyone to see the finished project that is long overdue! In addition to this, we have made improvements to the Oakleaf room that provides a consistent look with the rest of the clubhouse. We are in the process of installing an automatic chemical system at the pool complex that will allow us to maintain the pools to the highest safety standard possible for our members and guests.

There are many exciting events in the coming months that you will not want to miss, such as our annual Après Ski Party, Valentine's Day Dinner, MGA Super Bowl Golf Tournament, Ladies Night, Live Music Nights and more!

We are excited to announce that we will soon receive our "Special Oaks Blend" of Makers Mark this spring that was personally designed by a few of our club members with the assistance of staff from Makers Mark Distillery. A course update from the Grounds Superintendent...

It's hard to believe that we are only 4-5 weeks away from aerating the greens and kicking off another golf season. With the addition of the Boy's 6A State Championship May 6/7- aeration is scheduled for as early as possible (weather pending), with mid-March as a target date. This will be a fantastic opportunity to highlight our club, particularly our golf course and all the improvements that have been made over the past few years.

As many of you are aware, this past summer we began a number of processes to protect areas of the course from winter damage. This includes soil amendments around the greens, approaches, and collars. In addition, we applied wetting agents to many areas of the golf course and applied additional irrigation to the golf course ahead of the winter weather to provide additional protection from the potential freezing weather. We hope that with these preparations along with other preparations, we will come out of winter with limited damage to our golf course from the cold temperatures we have had. We are already monitoring site specific areas on the golf course by pulling plugs and are incubating them in house and through Oklahoma State University to determine the health of the plant ahead of spring that will allow us to prepare better for the spring. This will be on-going for the next couple of months.

We are proud of the golf course projects we have completed this winter so far. Highlights would be the drainage projects we have done on #12 fairway, around the putting green, and the left side of the 15th green. These projects will improve turf conditions, as well as dry up chronic wet areas that keep us restricted to cart paths that one extra day. More areas have been identified, and over time we will get drains in them to continue to improve the course. A small area in the landing area on #2 fairway, and several areas on the pitch and putt course have been identified for the next scheduled work.

The new rest room on the back nine is coming along nicely, plans are being made to get the landscaping in and get it cleaned up just as soon as it is finished.

It is also time to get our annual "winter dormant spray" down. Considering the forecasted rain for this weekend - it will start around February 5.

We are also making plans for a project around the second green and the third tee. The primary change will be moving the existing cart path to the right side of the back tee complex and re-grassing everything in between the second green and the third tee. This project will start as soon as the greens are aerated in the spring, subject to weather.

As you can see there is a lot going on out on the golf course. Making these improvements is why we are here. We cannot wait to see how these things improve our golf course not only over the short term, but in the long haul as well.

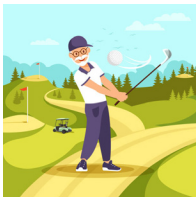

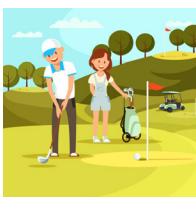

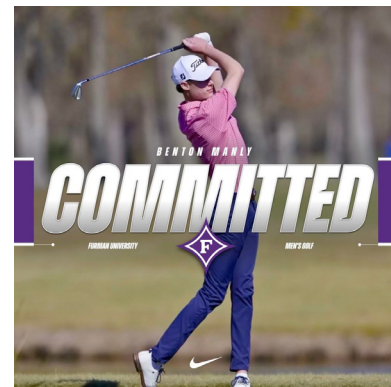
