Advisory Board Update

- o Turnover Outline Reviewed outline with the Board. Discussed timeline for various components and resources that might be utilized.
- o Director of Golf Search Process Currently formulating the formal search process and search committee. The Club will focus on taking the time to find the right candidate.
- o Club Rules and Regulations Update The Ridge short course and new tennis/pickleball facilities rules and regulations will be updated. Additional updates are being reviewed and will be sent out to the Advisory Board prior to distribution to the Membership.
- Member Discipline Process One suspension (30 days) and four violation letters occurred since the previous meeting.

- Putting Course Opening of the putting green has been delayed due to the sod being damaged over the winter.
- O Hole 9 Walkers and Private Carts Discussed the increased usage of cart paths during play. Walking the course will not be allowed when the course is open and private carts, or any other form of personal transportation, will not be permitted on the course at any time.
- o Comfort Stations Improvements have been very well received!
- o Discussion around water usage on the course; consider drying out the course somewhat.
