LAS VEGAS Moving checklist

8 WEEKS BEFORE THE MOVE

- Start researching Las Vegas neighborhoods (Enterprise, Summerlin, Henderson, Southern Highlands, Lake Las Vegas, etc.)
- Visit or schedule virtual tours of homes with your realtor
- Hire a local Las Vegas real estate expert (Hi, I can help with that!)
- Set your moving budget
- Research and get quotes from moving companies
- Create a moving folder (digitally or printed) for receipts, quotes, and paperwork
- Begin decluttering sell, donate, or toss what you don't need

6 WEEKS BEFORE THE MOVE

- Book your moving company or rental truck
- Gather school records and begin school registration if you have kids
- Schedule time off from work for the move
- If buying, begin loan pre-approval process and gather financial documents
- Order moving supplies (boxes, tape, labels, markers, etc.)
- Start packing non-essential items
- Notify your landlord if you're renting

4 WEEKS BEFORE THE MOVE

- File a change of address with USPS: <u>www.usps.com</u>
- Notify banks, credit cards, subscriptions, and insurance companies
- Set up or transfer utilities (NV Energy, Southwest Gas, water/sewer, trash)
- Plan for internet/cable installation (Cox, CenturyLink, etc.)
- Schedule movers or friends/family to help
- Continue packing room by room
- Confirm moving truck access if you're moving to/from a high-rise or gated community

2 WEEKS BEFORE THE MOVE

Update driver's license and vehicle registration with the Nevada DMV

Pack an "Essentials" box for the first night (clothes, toiletries, chargers, basic kitchenware)

Dispose of hazardous items (paint, cleaning supplies, propane tanks)

Refill prescriptions and transfer them to a Las Vegas pharmacy

Eat through pantry and freezer items

Confirm all move-in dates and logistics

1 WEEK BEFORE THE MOVE

- Final walkthrough of your current home
- Deep clean or schedule a cleaning service
- Confirm movers and address
- Label boxes clearly by room and fragility
- Pack suitcases with clothes for a few days
- Set up home security (optional but recommended for new homeowners)

MOVING DAY

- Do a final sweep of old home
- Take photos of utilities and home condition (for rentals or selling)
- ☐ Welcome movers and direct them as needed
- Check off inventory list
- Tip movers if applicable
- Celebrate you're officially a Las Vegas local!

AFTER THE MOVE

- Unpack essentials first
- Register to vote in Nevada
- Explore your new neighborhood
- Meet the neighbors
- Update your address for any remaining accounts
- Leave a review for your movers or realtor
