WHAT IS SCRIP?

Scrip is a trade- cash or check for a gift card from a participating merchant. The merchant donates a percentage of the total gift card amount to the parish.

HOW DO I GET SCRIP?

Fill out a scrip order form before or after Mass located at the back table of church.





PAYMENT

All order forms must be accompanied with payment in full by cash or check.
