**Antisocial behaviour**



**Antisocial behaviour can include:**

- noise
- shouting, swearing and fighting
- intimidation of neighbours and others through threats or actual violence
- harassment, including racial harassment or sectarian aggression.
- verbal abuse
- abusive behaviour aimed at causing distress or fear
- dumping rubbish
- animal nuisance, including dog fouling
- vandalism, property damage and graffiti
- drug use
- defecating in public spaces
- nudity in public spaces



If you are concerned about a situation or suspect criminal activity might have taken place, **please call the police to discuss the matter.**




**Call 101:**


- Report a crime not currently in progress – for example a stolen car, burglary, or damaged property.
- Give information to the police about crime in your area.
- Speak to the police about a general enquiry.
- Contact a specific police officer or member of staff.

You can also contact Crimestoppers to report a crime anonymously. They will pass the information about the crime to the police.
