 <p><b>Food waste bin</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ All uneaten food, plate or bowl scrapings, out of date or mouldy food</li> <li>✓ Dairy products (cheese, eggs, and egg shells, yoghurts)</li> <li>✓ Bread, cakes and pastries</li> <li>✓ Raw and cooked meat and bones</li> <li>✓ Raw and cooked fish and fish bones</li> <li>✓ Raw and cooked fruit and vegetables and peelings</li> <li>✓ Rice, pasta and beans</li> <li>✓ Tea and coffee bags and grounds</li> <li>✓ Pet food</li> <li>✓ Cooking oil – sealed in a plastic bottle and put inside your outdoor food waste bin</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✗ Packaging of any kind (including compostable or biodegradable packaging)</li> <li>✗ Large amounts of liquids such as milk</li> <li>✗ Garden waste and cut flowers</li> <li>✗ Pet waste, litter or bedding</li> <li>✗ Any material that isn't food</li> </ul>
