Join us as we partner with Mission of Hope to pack life-changing meals for vulnerable children in Haiti. These meals do more than satisfy hunger - they open the door for children to receive an education, experience a brighter future, and hear the life-changing message of the Gospel.

There are several meaningful ways you can be part of this ministry:

PRAY - Partner with us by praying for this event, the volunteers serving, and the children and families in Haiti who will receive these meals.

VOLUNTEER - There is a place for everyone! We need volunteers of all ages to serve as packers, station leaders, loaders, activity leaders for children, greeters, and check-in assistants.

GIVE - Help us reach our goal of 40,000 meals by raising \$14,000. Every gift makes a difference:

- \$0.35 provides one meal.
- \$76 sponsors one box of meals.
- \$1,000 sponsors an entire packing station.
