# When's the last time you went to confession?

**Edie Iron Moccasin**

**Cook and Factotum for the ministers of Eagle Butte for 36 years**

Edie Iron Moccasin was a faithful and hardworking employee at the Catholic Pastoral Center in Eagle Butte from 1985 to 2021. I met her when I came here in 2015 for my first assignment after ordination. She graciously handled the various personalities of probably around 50 different priests and brothers that cycled through the staff, not to mention the many sisters, randos, and seminarians that stayed for summer camps or apprentice programs. She worked around their various oddities and quirks and flaws (mine included) with grace and humility. She always came to work with a good attitude and worked efficiently and well. Most impressive to me personally, was how she always presented her happiest self at work, even when she was suffering from hardships of health or family concerns at home. After you began visiting with her at length she might reveal a personal concern or ask for prayers for something, but if you never inquired, you would never know that something was weighing heavy on her mind.

A factotum is an employee who performs a wide variety of tasks. This was Edie. She helped fold bulletins, she cleaned, she did laundry, yardwork, painting, visits to the sick, stamped envelopes, picked up groceries and supplies, cleaned up Legos after priests got done playing (as mentioned, we have our quirks, but to be fair I made that up... but she certainly cleaned up puzzles or cards, and I wouldn't doubt if there was a priest who dabbled in Legos too!) and many other odd jobs too numerous to enumerate. She was always so easy to tease because she had a genuinely carefree attitude, and laughed heartily at her own expense. She could also dish it right back to us. She knew us all so well, she could scold us like a mother does her children and then make us laugh about it. But most of all, what she did most wonderfully and most often, was cooked for the priests. She could cook a three course meal for 5 people in under an hour. And then serve a healthy dessert. She always cooked the noon meal on weekdays and she always cooked enough so that we had leftovers for supper and for weekends. We often had fist-fights over her leftovers. I made that up too; but, sometimes the subtle maneuverings for those leftovers were almost as palpable as a fist-fight. Truly we can all say those words literally: “For I was hungry and you gave me food.” Dear Edie, you were a blessing to us and now we commend you to God with grateful hearts, asking God to forgive your sins, look upon all the good you have done, and grant you everlasting life with Jesus Christ, who is Lord forever and ever. Amen.
