To improve the affordability of the licensure process, Bethany's Education Department secured a donor in 2019 who has provided funds for licensure tests. The stipend covers a combination of PRAXIS test fees per student teacher within the academic year up to \$215 per student teacher, and in some cases, includes additional study materials or online practice tests. In 2024-2025, there were 15 of 16 student teachers who utilized the Praxis Test Fund.
