

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT FOR NURSING

Between

Bethany College of Lindsborg, Kansas

and

Hesston College of Hesston, Kansas

1. Hesston College encourages the application of pre-nursing students who have completed, or have in progress, more than 62 credit hours of study at Bethany College.
2. Liberal Education and Support Course Requirements:

Bethany College students should also complete two additional Humanities courses (or one course if completing RL200/RL210) with a grade of C or better selected from different subjects of the following:



3. Before students can begin Nursing Foundations I, which is offered in fall semesters, they must successfully complete at least 62 credit hours of liberal education and support courses with a cumulative GPA of 2.50 in

those required courses. Remaining courses that may be completed after matriculation into the Hesston College Nursing Program include only Biblical Literature, other Humanities courses, and electives.


4. Bethany students with a 3.0 or higher GPA on required coursework, and two positive references from Bethany faculty and/or staff, will be guaranteed admission to the Hesston program.
5. Interested students should apply to the Hesston College Admissions Office by March 1 of the year prior to their anticipated Hesston enrollment. Required materials include a Hesston College Application for Admission; Hesston College Nursing Program Application; two references; official high school and college transcripts; and official ACT, SAT, or ACCUPLACER test scores.
6. Bethany academic advisors can work with the Hesston College Nursing Education Director for advice and information on meeting requirements, and the Director will visit Bethany for informational presentations to interested students, as requested.
7. Bethany and Hesston will include information about this agreement in their college catalogs and selected promotional materials.
8. Significant changes in the Hesston general education program will be communicated to the Bethany Registrar by the Vice President of Academics or his/her designee.
9. This agreement will be reviewed biennially by the Vice President of Academics, or his/her designee, and may be revised by mutual consent.
10. This agreement will continue in force indefinitely, but may be terminated by either party with written notice of at least two years.


