At Camp Riverside, we understand the importance of a strong team to ensure youth have a safe, fun and equitable summer experience. So for us, finding the right people to work at camp is a top priority.

OUR STAFF

Every summer we build a strong team of returning staff, new hires, and transfers from our Taunton and Brockton Clubhouses. We celebrate diversity in background, experience and thought in our camp family, consisting of Counselors, Activity Specialists, Unit Leaders and Camp Directors who are passionate about working with youth, believe in the importance of summer camp in youth development, and embody the camp philosophies of kindness and growth.

OUR HIRING POLICIES

As part of our commitment to hire the very best staff at Camp Riverside, all new hires are required to go through two interviews, submit four references, and complete state and federal background checks. All counselors must be at least 18 years old by the start of camp.

OUR STAFF TRAINING

All staff receive almost two weeks of pre-summer training, where we cover key topics such as camper safety, emergency procedures, camp games & activities, first aid & CPR, and behavior management. Our training doesn't end when campers arrive, with our Unit Leaders and Camp Directors committed to providing on-the-job training for counselors, to help them develop and grow throughout the summer.

JUNIOR COUNSELORS

As part of our commitment to empower and support youth in their transitions to adulthood, we also hire a small team of Junior Counselors, aged 16-17. Junior Counselors receive hands-on, practical experience to help prepare them for careers in the 21st century. These positions are reserved for former campers and participants of our Counselor In Training program, who understand the camper experience well, and are driven to provide an awesome summer experience. Junior Counselors are never left solely in charge of a group of campers, and are paired with experienced, returning camp counselors to aid in their continued development.
