GOSPEL MEDITATION – A DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

In today's society, there is a need for people to bear witness to your Gospel in the midst of the world; yet, for those who take that risk, there are countless obstacles standing in their way. They face threats, forced disappearances, and, all too often, the loss of their lives. Nevertheless, the invitation to proclaim your Word remains: “We must always pray to the Lord of the harvest—God the Father—to send laborers to work in his field, which is the world. And each of us must do so with an open heart and a missionary spirit; our prayer should not be limited merely to our own petitions and needs, for a prayer is truly Christian only if it also embraces a universal dimension” (Pope Francis, July 7, 2019).

What am I willing to do for priestly and religious vocations in my diocese? What do I do for the committed laypeople in my parish? We must all cooperate so that the Kingdom of God may grow; we are all God's people and the sheep of his flock (Psalm 99). “You received without payment; give without payment” (Matthew 10:8). It is the gratitude born of faith that keeps us steadfast in our mission. God gives to us abundantly; His mercy manifests itself in many ways—in our families, at work, at university, and indeed, He is with us at the dawn of every new day. Therefore, it is urgent that we collaborate with God in some way: “Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers for his harvest” (Matthew 9:38). ©LPi
