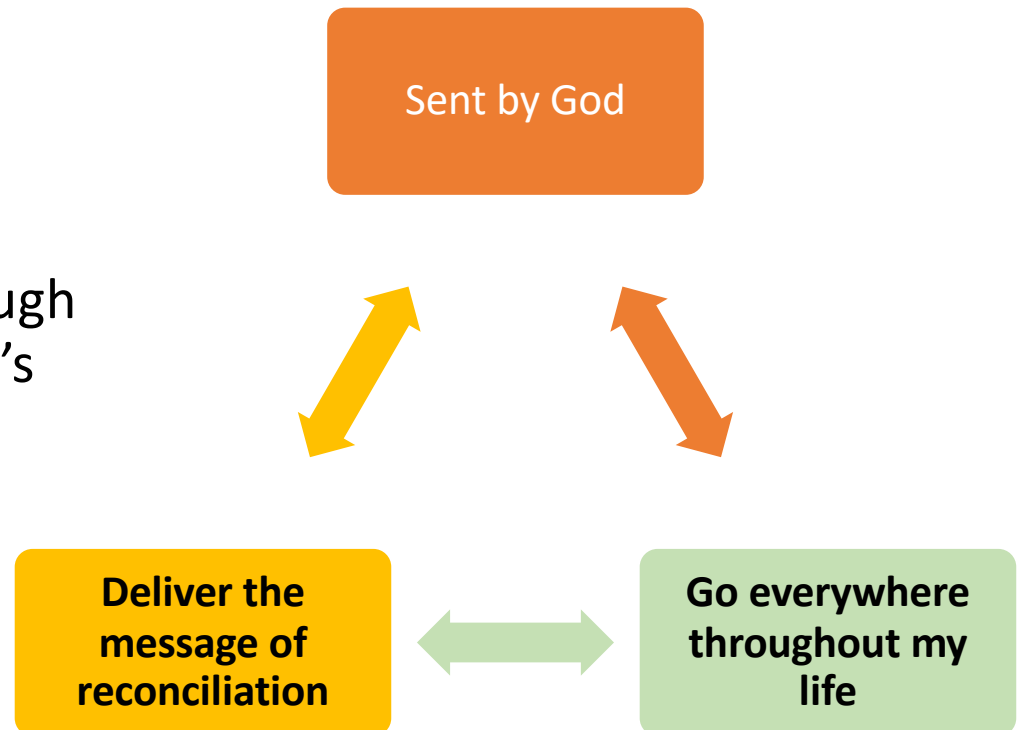


Order of the Event

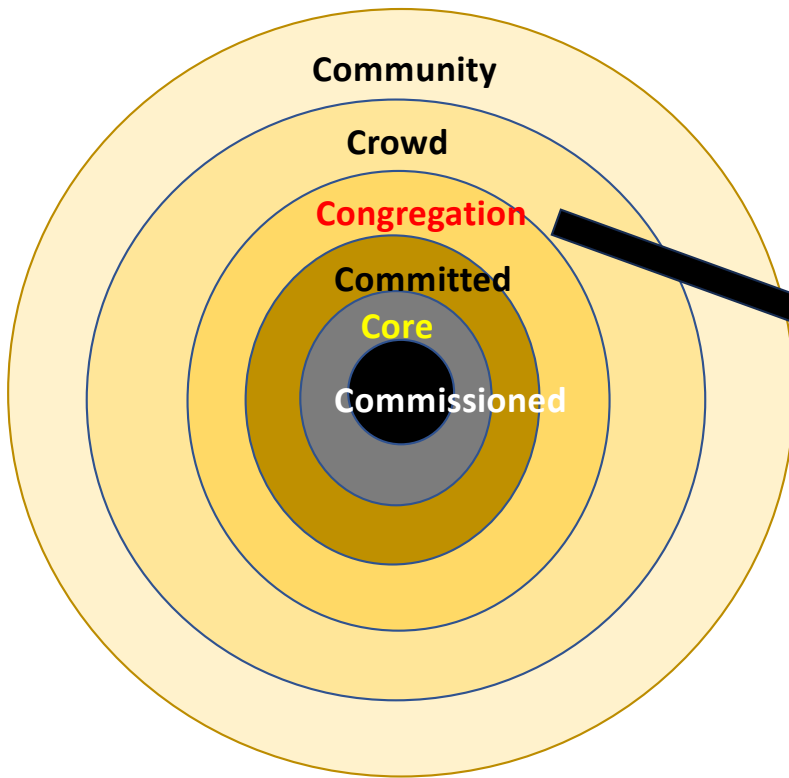
- Sing together (Amazing Grace)

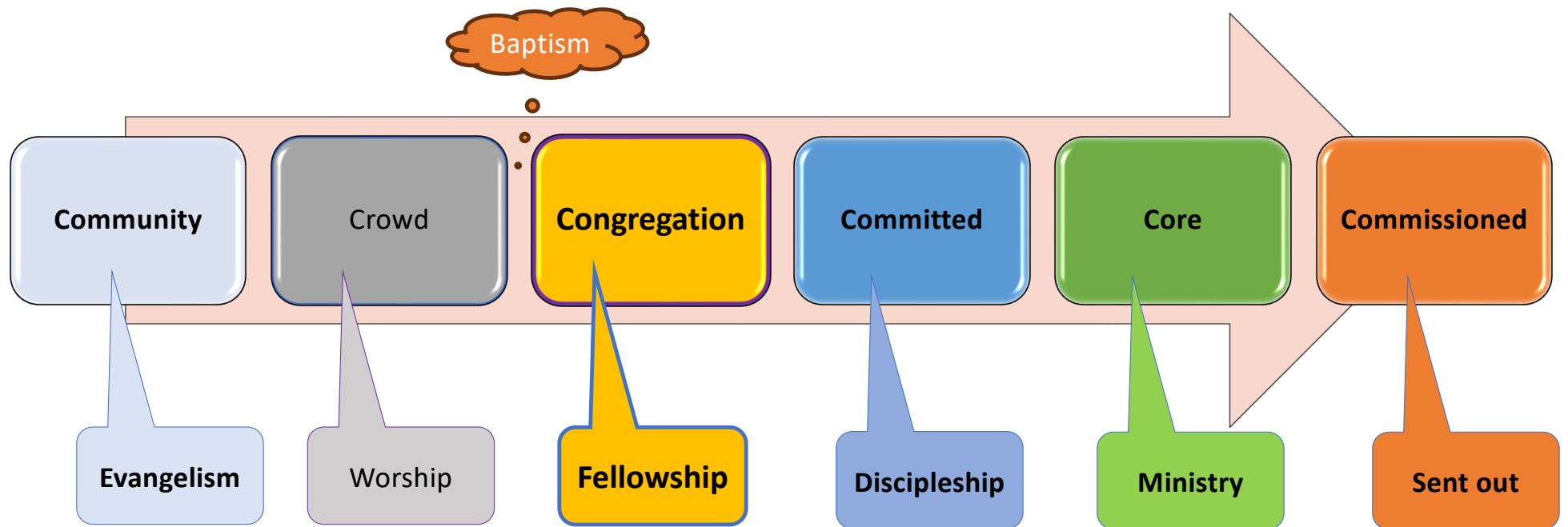


Identifying the target



The Community	The uncommitted people who live within your ministry area
The Crowd	The people who are committed to attending worship each week
The Congregation	Those who have committed to membership
The Committed	Those who have committed to maturity
The Core	Those who have committed to ministry
The Commissioned	Those who have committed to their mission

Different Strategies Needed to Each Target



The Ministry of Reconciliation

- The Nature of the Office: You are a Representative, not a Tourist.
 - A tourist is in a place for their own pleasure; an Ambassador is there on official business.
 - You no longer represent your own opinions or moods; you represent the King. When people see you, they should see the character and love of Christ.
- The Core Message: The Word of Reconciliation.
 - Your job is to bridge the gap between two parties (God and Man).
 - Your 12 weeks of training were for the "ministry of reconciliation." Your goal is to help people move from being "strangers to God" to "children of God."
- The Authority: You Carry the King's Seal.
 - You speak with the full authority of the government that sent you.
 - When you face spiritual warfare or difficult mission fields, you do not go alone. You have the full backing of Heaven's resources.

Call to Action

- The First Assignment: Week 13 task
 - Identifying one person in your life who needs to hear the "message of reconciliation" and praying for them specifically.
- Lead a mentoring relationship
 - Initiate a one-on-one mentoring relationship with someone by leading them through the 12 sessions using the materials provided on the website.
- Continue to learn
 - Regularly read, review, and apply the ambassador training materials in your personal life and ministry.
- Stay connected
 - Continue to participate in the Shalom Zoom worship, where you can keep sharpening your competencies with other ambassadors.
- Engage in further training
 - Attend the follow-up training program (Contact pastor Marc Musimbi for details).

Ambassador Pledge

- Recognition of Divine Calling

- Pastor: Will you earnestly seek to carry forward your ministry in sincerity and in love, cooperating willingly with your coworkers, and striving to be a positive influence to those around you; to contribute to the spirit of love, joy and harmony, making this ministry a peaceful work environment?
- All: I will, the Lord being my helper

- All in unison
