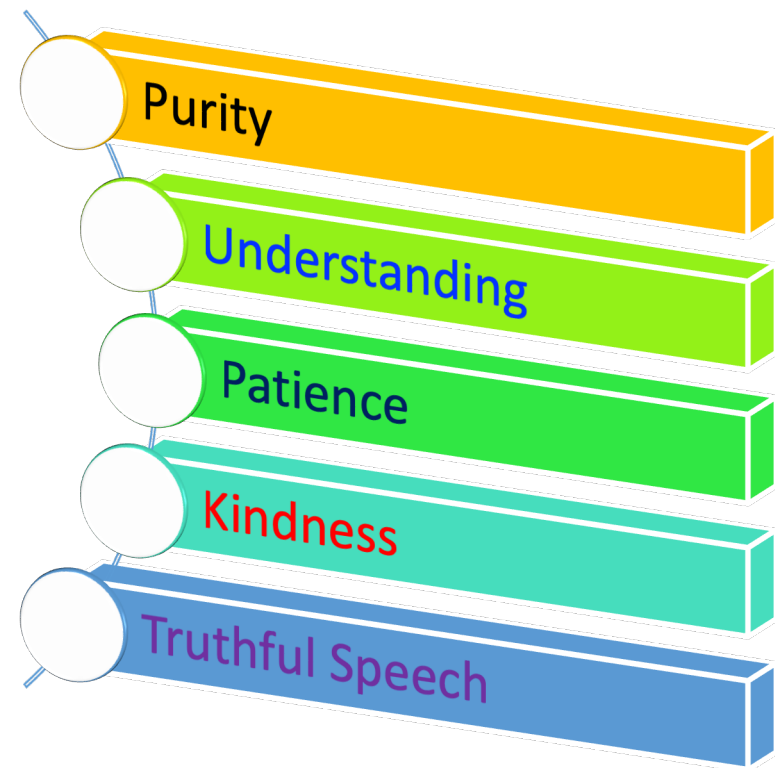
Qualities of an Effective Ambassador for Christ



- Good Character (five dispositional traits)
 - Purity, understanding, patience, kindness and truthful speech.
- Be intelligent & knowledgeable in the Bible
 - Read/Meditate the Bible regularly.
 - Gift of knowledge & wisdom.
- Skills and wisdom
 - Encourage others wisely and enthusiastically to accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

Disposition (Good Character)

- Ambassadors must be Christlike in character
 - Knowledge puffs up while love builds up (1 Corinthians 8:1).
 - Be mature with abundant display of the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23).
 - Not a novice (He must not be a recent convert, 1 Timothy 3:6).
 - As servants of God we commend ourselves in every way...in purity, understanding, patience and kindness; in the Holy Spirit and in sincere love; in truthful speech and in the power of God; with weapons of righteousness in the right hand and in the left (2 Corinthians 6:4-7).



Five Dispositional Traits



- **Purity**
 - Sexual purity, morally clean, demonstrating integrity, love, empathy and good heart.
- **Understanding**
 - In-depth understanding of the Christian worldview
 - Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth (2 Timothy 2:15).
 - Ambassadors demonstrate the biblical disposition and lifestyle daily.
- **Patience**
 - Being long-tempered, listen patiently, showing empathy by listening carefully.
- **Kindness**
 - Treating others with respect; seeing others in God's image.
 - Do you show contempt for the riches of his kindness, forbearance and patience, not realizing that God's kindness is intended to lead you to repentance (Romans 2:4).
- **Truthful speech**
 - Boldly proclaim the gospel with kindness, even in difficult situations.

Be Intelligent and Knowledgeable in the Bible

- Ambassadors must have the knowledge of the Word of God
 - He must hold firmly to the trustworthy **message** as it has been taught, so that he can encourage others by sound doctrine (Titus 1:9).
 - Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have (1 Peter 3:15).
- Knowing the themes and core values of the Bible
 - The biblical themes: God, His revealed works of creation, provision, judgment, deliverance, His covenant, and His promises.
 - The most common theme: 1) We are lost without God; 2) God loves us and wants to save us and give us eternal life.
 - The Grand Story of Scripture.

- Why is it important to read the Bible? **7 Reasons.**
 - The Bible nourishes you (1 Peter 2:2, Matthew 4:4).
 - The Bible gives you light (Psalm 119:105, 2 Peter 1:19).
 - The Bible waters you (Colossians 2:7, Deuteronomy 32:1-2).
 - The Bible is God's way of speaking to you (Matthew 6:12).
 - The Bible is the source of your faith (Romans 10:17).
 - The Bible sanctifies you (1 John 2:15, John 17:17).
 - The Bible equips you to defeat the devil (2 Timothy 2:22).



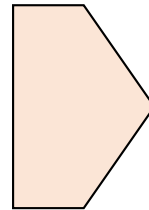
Great commission + Great commandment = Great Ambassador

Great Commandment

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind...Love your neighbor as yourself (Matthew 22:37-40).

Great Commission

Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you (Matt 28:19-20)



Purposes of Ambassador's Life

Worship (Magnify)

- Love the Lord with all your heart.

Ministry (Service)

- Love your neighbor as yourself.

Mission (Evangelism)

- Go and make disciples.

Fellowship (Belong)

- Baptizing them.

Discipleship (Maturity)

- Teaching them to obey.

Wisdom and Persuasiveness



- Why wisdom and persuasiveness matter?
 - All ambassadors' character and biblical knowledge should be deployed effectively so that others may accept Jesus.
 - We put no stumbling block in anyone's path, so that our ministry will not be discredited (2 Corinthians 6:3).
- Four spiritual laws
 1. God loves you and created you to know Him personally;
 2. Man is sinful and separated from God, so we cannot know Him personally or experience His love;
 3. Jesus Christ is God's only provision for man's sin. Through Him alone we can know God personally and experience God's love;
 4. You must individually receive Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord, then you can know God personally and experience His love.

- How to encourage others to accept Jesus as their Lord and Savior?
 - Understand that getting people saved is a spiritual battle;
 - Know that it takes the power of the Holy Spirit to get people saved;
 - Pray a lot and earnestly for the people you are encouraging to make a decision for Jesus;
 - Live an exemplary life;
 - Share your testimonies;
 - Invite them to meetings;
 - Be patient with them.

- **Disposition (The Heart of the Ambassador)**
