Net Set Go....With the introduction to many players, coaches, managers, umpires and parents this year we had a few hiccups in the beginning but after a coaches and umpires meeting a lot of anomalies were sorted and Net Set Go progressed. It is a learning curve for everyone. Netball Australia did a lot of research into the program before asking the states to introduce it. From 2014 onwards all players ten years and under will be involved in the program. Congratulations to all those involved for their patience in implementing a very successful program.

A very big thank you to Jenny and Sarah along with university student Jarrod, for assisting in the running of the Skills Program. Our representative players were all rostered on to help and I think that at times they had more fun than the participants! Well done everyone. We were very lucky to have Susan Pratley come along on our presentation day. She seemed to have more fun than playing GS/GA for the NSW Swifts. A total of 71 players were registered this year.

Lights....Everything seemed to go very smoothly this year. Clubs have become more aware of the benefits of getting their schedules in on time and being the allocated courts that they needed. I would like to point out though that some teams were just turning up and using other clubs allocated courts unbeknown to their own club! Would all clubs please make sure that they know where and when their teams are training for next season otherwise you are paying for someone else to train on your allocated court.

Representative As acting rep convenor this year I certainly had to cover a lot of ground during the season. We had all of our junior State Age Representative teams in Championship division. This is a credit to all the previous coaches and managers that these girls have had as well as their current ones. The Championships were played at Campbelltown in the wettest conditions that I have ever encountered. Tracy and I along with coaches, managers and spectators were all wearing gumboots! A first for most of us. Our junior development teams were a credit to us throughout the season. How lucky are we to have such support in our reps. Expenditure in 2013 has exceeded income by \$15,619.00 and this has been due to timing of payments as for example there is a payment for 2012 State Age accommodation costs which was made in the first week of July 2012 but this really belongs to 2012 expenditure.

I did recommend in 2012 that we need to align our accounting year to closely reflect our actual operational year of the Association and in doing this we can have a more accurate picture of our accounts. This will be officially put to Council at our next meeting.

Council did agree to proceed with the final stage of court upgrades and this will then eat into our reserves but will also provide us with greatly improved courts which will in turn allow flexibility in playing times plus the ability to host other events.

Many thanks to The Hawkesbury Sports Council for their assistance during the year.

As part of our AGM we need to consider fees for the 2014 year. At the time of providing this report we have details of proposed Netball NSW fees but not the Hawkesbury Sports Council fees. Netball NSW are proposing to the November meeting an approximate \$2.00 per member increase in fees and these have now been included in our fees.

The Hawkesbury Sports Council do not review their fees until December but in the past they have increased generally by CPI. I have therefore allowed a \$0.20 increase in their fees.

In addition to the NSW fees and Sports Council fees I have allowed an approximate \$2.00 increase in our fees (rounded up to make an even dollar).

Registrars Report 2013 – Judy Burns

A huge thank you to all the clubs registrars for their fantastic effort throughout the year.

We registered over 1400 players in 151 teams; 22 Net Set Go Teams, 72 junior Teams and 57 Senior Teams.

I would encourage clubs to attract more players especially in the younger divisions so that we can create more equal competitions. Clubs will consider placing 10's and 11's together and 12's and 13's together so we could have some mixed teams as well as some of the same age and possible 4 divisions in each group. There will also be the possibility of creating an intermediate / cadets group that could have 6 divisions. This could look like D1 – top 15 to 17 year olds

D2 – next 15 to 17 year olds

D3 – top 14/15 year olds

D4 – average 15-17 year olds

D5 – 14 years with 1 or 2, 15 year olds

D6 - social 14/17 year olds

Would give the graders room to move teams to the most suitable competition.

253 players played “up” in higher divisions throughout 2013 showing that there is a real need for players to be able to do this, also that many players are happy to play two games in a day. Many country associations allow junior (14/15) players to play their game and also be registered in a senior team.

In 2014 players will be allowed to play 5 games in higher divisions however if they play up in the same team 3 times they will become part of that team and once they have played the 5th game in higher divisions they will become part of the last team they played up in.

Playing an ineligible player will cost the team 2 competition points and no goals will be recorded.

In 2013 the score sheets will not need to be signed, the team manager/ coach/ captain will fill in the score sheet with the positions that players are playing, this will show who is on the court in each quarter.

Spread sheets to be completed next year before registration will have players colour coded according to the division they played in in 2013 and will show where the team was placed. Please keep these colours the same when creating teams next year as it will make it obvious to graders where players have played.

If we have more hard courts in 2014 we really don't need 5 time slots, we could begin at 9.00 and end at 3.00 or start at 10 and end at 4.30.
