On the surface income has exceeded expenditure by approx. \$98,000.00 however it needs to be noted that our year ends 30 June and not all expenses have been paid in the year 1/7/14 to 30/6/15. Of particular note a \$65,000.00 payment for 2015 registrations was made to Netball NSW in July and this should be taken into account when considering the overall financial position.

In maybe better to consider a financial year ending 31 August so that the majority of income and expenditure is accounted for in the playing year.

Many thanks to The Hawkesbury Sports Council for their assistance during the year and in particular the assistance given during the State Age weekend.

As part of our AGM we need to consider fees for the 2015 year. The Associations will vote on 2016 fees at the November NSW meeting and unfortunately at the time of completing this report NSW have not provided a recommendation for proposed fees. We would however propose that our fees are increased in line with both NSW and The Sports Council with the HCNA component remaining the same as for 2015 only allowing for rounding.

## **COACHING CONVENOR & PLAYER DEVELOPMENT – Heather Smith**

This year I focused on “grass roots” netball beginning with an invitation to NSG & new coaches to attend a discussion and information group, although only a small number of coaches attended (mainly first time coaches). Viv Bertenshaw and myself were able to offer them the benefit of our experience. Nicole Peare and myself then formatted coaching hints and handed them out to over 70 parents so this response was positive.

My next venture was much more successful when 11 coaches attained their Foundation Accreditation from Netball NSW.

By far the most successful coaching day was 10yrs/U Fun/Activity Day when 8 young Hawkesbury coaches demonstrated and coached basic skills for 45 young players. They were assisted by Umpires Convenor Sue Orr & Fran Turnbull who concentrated on the stepping rule especially for our 10 year olds who were nominating for representative trials later in the year.

I followed up with a session by Lisa Beehag, Head Coach from Penrith who did a workshop for coaches this also was well attended although we were a bit hampered as it was a very cold night and the demonstration was outdoors. Following this Lisa was announced as the coach of Panther’s premier League team and one of our own Kay Minchin was appointed as her Manager.

Our involvement with Penrith, and Blue Mountains in the newly formed Premier League will offer another avenue not only for our players but also to our coaches and managers already some of our Hawkesbury players have participated in the trials. On 25<sup>th</sup> September Swifts player Susan Pettit (nee Pratley) will be in attendance at Hawkesbury to conduct her own coaching clinic which can only benefit our players especially budding representative players.

I also held a second Accreditation Day for 5 coaches 2 from Hawkesbury 2 from Manly and 1 from Penrith who were successful in gaining Development Accreditation. I will be holding more Accreditation days however this depends on the dates that we are allocated by Netball NSW.

I wish to remind all coaches, managers & primary carers involved with players under the age of 18 years on they must enroll for WWC (Working With Children) Certificate. A record of this number should be kept by your Club Executives and produced if required by Child Protection Agency who will be conducting inspections in 2016. The certificate is obtained free of charge by all voluntary workers and can be completed your computer, on completion attendance at the Motor Registry will validate your number.

My congratulations for all coaches and hope that next year we will be able to offer more help to club coaches who after all are the backbone of the Association. As we encourage young coaches to participate we should ensure their role is not only to coach the skills of netball but they must encourage and guide them in good sportsmanship and respect for umpires.

Club executives also have a duty of care to their coaches and umpires to make parents and spectators aware that all coaches, umpires and administrators are volunteers and they are coaching children to enjoy the sport of netball by example.

## **Registrars Report – Judy Burns**

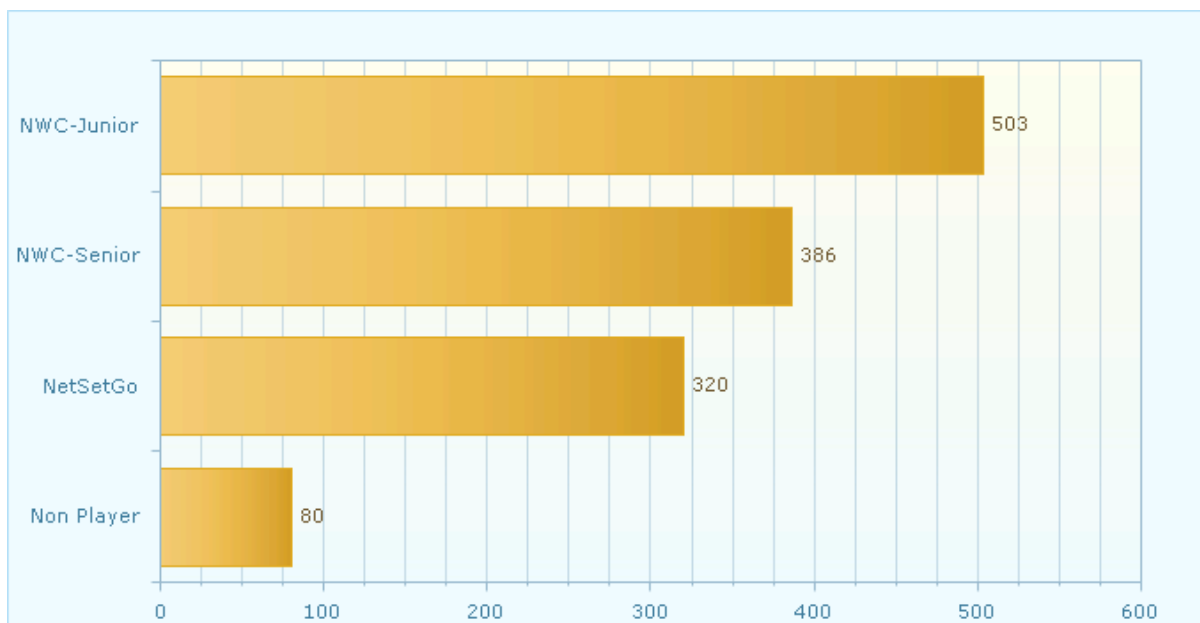

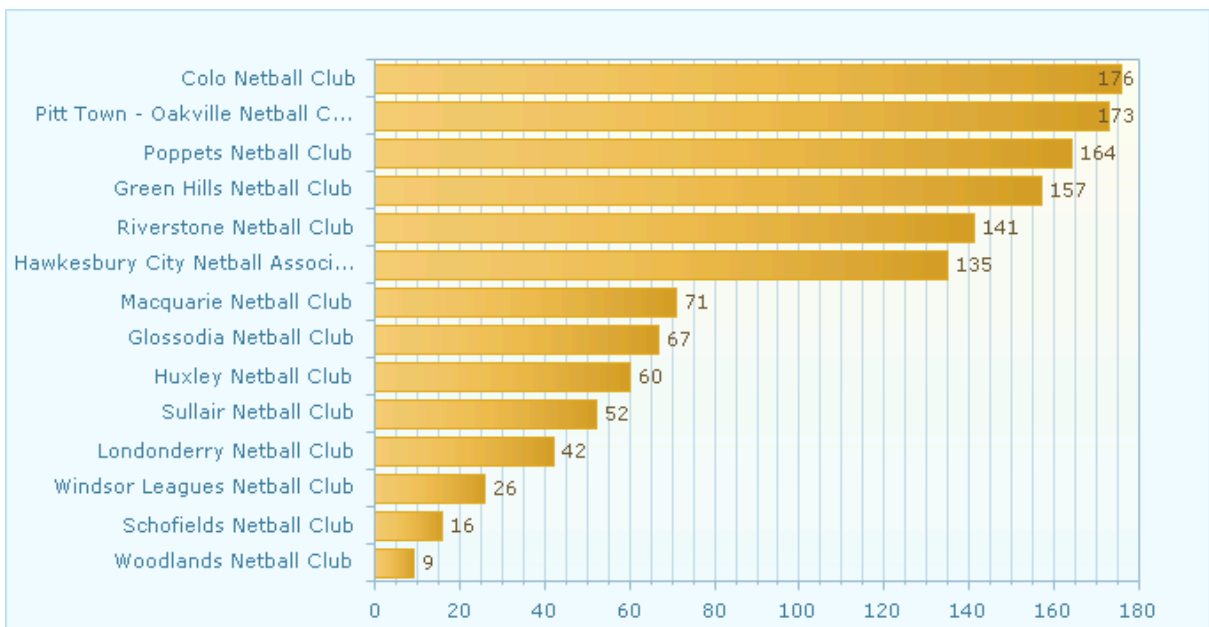

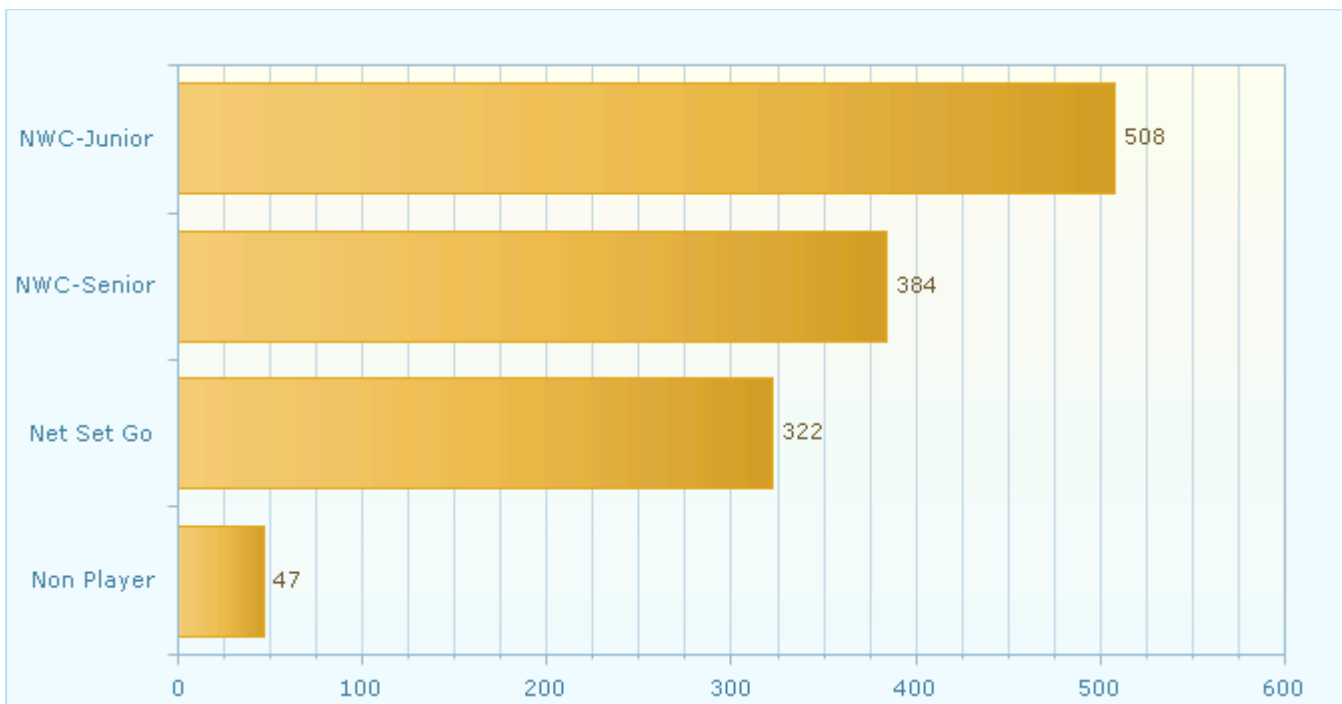
Registration breakdown is as follows and there is a comparison graph with 2014

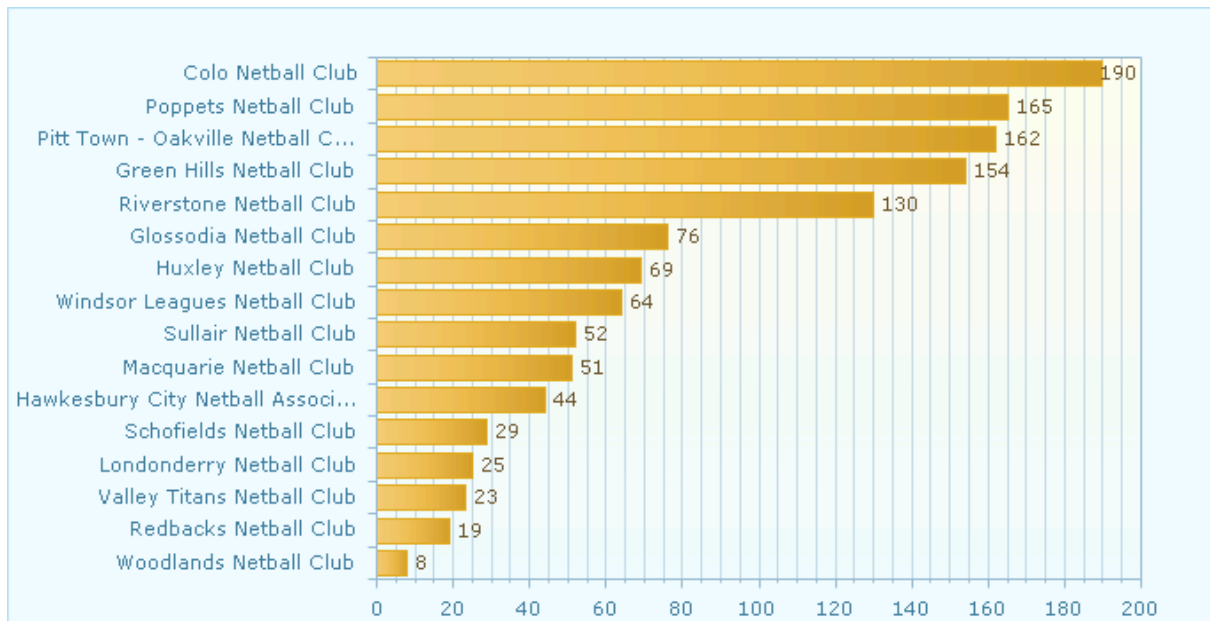
### Registrations 2015
