Thank you to all the clubs for the work they do and their support of Executive this year. Play HQ has been a learning experience but it seems to be working well and an easier platform to navigate than the old system. After 2 disrupted years it was nice to have a whole season.

We had 24 Net Set Go teams and 107 junior and senior teams which puts us around the same number as pre COVID with 246 Net Set Go players and 1139 juniors and seniors.

The final divisions appeared to produce reasonably even competitions and some very close games. For 2023 10 year olds will register as junior players so Net Set Go will be for 9 years and under, if teams have a 9 year old they want in the junior competition they need to register as juniors (unless Play HQ has been changed). Also I would like regrading to occur once a joined division such as 1 / 2 or A Grade, has played a whole round rather than set as Week 5.

It would also be good if Net Set Go White finished on preliminary final day and had their presentation then to make grand final day a little simpler.

Finally thank you personally to all the club executive who have supported me in this role or as registrar, for the last 10 years with the declining health of my husband I find it too difficult to be at netball every week so will not be standing for this position.
