Once again thank you to all the club executives who manage to put teams on the court. I know the job is thankless at times and there is little support but there would be no netball without you.

A big thank you to Jeannie for all her work this year and I am sure she will be a great help to Karlee in 2024.

As this was the first season in three years that wasn't greatly affected by COVID we were able to regrade and see the problems caused with Play HQ . I think we ended up with quite equitable grades and for the future I suggest:

- All 10 year olds must register as Juniors (there can be the odd exception for good reasons and hopefully we can find a way to place them in Net Set Go teams)
- 8 or 9 Year olds that play in Jun 1 must register as Juniors so they can be placed in teams
- Where possible grades/ divisions should have 5 / 6 teams this allows more equal divisions and then regrading would not cause the issues this year where whole new grades had to be formed (so no names on sheets)
- Clubs are using dual registrations to allow players to play up, it was pointed out that this was to help small clubs however large clubs are using it quite a bit. Do clubs feel it is a good idea or should it be limited?
- Intermediates could have 6 or 7 divisions and could be considered mixed to allow boys to continue playing beyond 12.

Based on the results this year clubs should have teams in the following divisions. Obviously there will be changes in players over the off season but as a guideline it would be good to consider this when forming teams so if you have a team in a higher division consider grading players to strengthen that instead of making 2 mixed ability teams
